LINCOLN SQUARE SYNAGOGUE ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES:

BEFORE YOU ATTEND

- If you or anyone in your household has been diagnosed with or exposed to the Coronavirus in the past 14 days, or if you have fever or any of the known COVID-19 symptoms, you may not attend.
- If you have returned within the past 14 days from a known “hot spot” or any region that requires quarantine (or have any questions about this), please contact Rabbi Robinson before coming to LSS.
- If you are at increased risk due to age or underlying medical conditions, you should consult with your physician and assess your risk level and tolerance before attending.
- You must pre-register and receive confirmation for all minyanim prior to attending.
- Due to the limited seating available, only those over Bar/Bat Mitzvah age are able to attend services at this time.
- Please take your temperature before you leave home, and do not come if you have a temperature of above 99.9 degrees.
- Please use the restroom at home before coming to shul, as restroom use at shul will be strictly limited.
- Please bring your own Siddur, Chumash and Tallis to shul with you, or use your phone for davening (on a weekday), as LSS will not supply these items for use at shul.
- You will be provided hand sanitizer before you enter LSS, but we encourage you to bring your own hand sanitizer to use, as appropriate, for added safety.

ENTERING THE SYNAGOGUE

- Please arrive 10-15 minutes before the scheduled time of the minyan, in order to allow time for the admittance procedure. Shul doors will be closed 5 minutes after the scheduled time of the minyan, with no further entry possible.
- Upon arriving at LSS, please line up, socially-distanced, from the main wood doors northward.

- Face masks must be worn at all times, from the time that you approach the building until the time that you leave, and must completely cover your mouth and your nose.
- Once you enter into the doors of LSS, a security guard, custodian or a minyan captain will:
 - verify that your name is on the list of pre-registered minyan attendees. If you have not registered in advance, you will not be admitted.
 - check your temperature using a non-contact thermometer. If you have a temperature of above 99.9 degrees, you will not be admitted.
 - require you to scrub your hands with an antibacterial sanitizer.
- For services that take place on the Spira Family terrace on the second floor, if elevator access is needed, only one person will be permitted in the elevator at any one time (except for caregivers of minyan attendees).

AFTER ENTERING THE SYNAGOGUE

- Once you have entered the shul, please do not walk around the building. Please walk directly to the minyan location (Spira Family Terrace or Nathaniel Richman Cohen Sanctuary) and choose a seat, without walking around the minyan location:
 - On the terrace, you may sit in any empty seat or a seat pair.
 - In the sanctuary, seats where sitting is permitted are marked. Marked seats that are side by side are reserved for members of the same household (e.g., parent and child).
- Once you have chosen a seat, please stay there for the duration of the services – please stand only in front of your seat, not next to it or behind it, and please do not daven in the aisle.
- Face masks must be worn, covering both your mouth and your nose, the entire time that you are on LSS premises.
- Please maintain social distancing (at least 6' apart) while entering and leaving LSS and while on shul premises.
- If you take off your mask during the service or fail to social distance, the minyan will be stopped by the minyan captain. If you do not comply with the minyan captain's instructions to fix the issue, you will be asked to leave, and you will most likely not be invited to another minyan.
- Other than the Baal Tefila, there will be no communal singing as part of the services at this time, due to COVID-19 related concerns.
- Everyone must use his/her own Siddur, Chumash and Tallis.
- Please do not leave your Siddur, Chumash and Tallis anywhere in shul after services. Cubbies and lockers are currently not to be used.
- Restrooms are for urgent use only; kindly utilize your home restroom before coming to shul. If restroom use is urgently required, please note that only one person will be permitted in the restroom at any time.
- On Shabbat, designated spots will be marked to wait for restroom access. A custodian will be stationed by the bathrooms and will provide you with hand sanitizer before you enter and after you leave the restroom, and will inform you when the bathroom is available for use.
- Following the service, please disperse immediately, following the directions of the minyan captain at all times. Please do not socialize and linger after services.
