Personal Loans up to \$8,000

These loans can be used to assist with personal needs including but not limited to:

- Living expenses
- Bills
- Rent arrears
- Medical & dental emergencies
- Simchas Bar & Bat Mitzvahs, weddings
- Burial, monument
- Compassionate travel
- Debt consolidation

Fertility Loans & Adoption Mr Loans up to \$10,000

These loans can be used to cover costs associated with fertility treatments and/or adoption.



Educational Loans up to \$12,000

Up to \$10,000 available for undergraduate studies at a university, college or trade school or for use on a gap-year program.

Up to \$12,000 available for graduate programs.

Business Loans up to \$10,000

Loans up to \$10,000 are available for start-up businesses.

Business loans will only be granted for the relief of poverty and to people for whom this new venture is their sole source of income

Available for Jewish Residents of Ontario in Need

All **JFLT** loans require guarantors with the exception of \$1,000 and Fertility Loans (when funds are available)

Loans between \$1001-\$3000 require one guarantor

Loans over \$3000 require 2 guarantors

Business Loans require 3 guarantors

GUARANTORS MUST BE:

- Canadian citizens or Permanent
- Over the age of 18
- Financially able to repay the loan if the borrower defaults
- It is preferable that at least one guarantor own property in Ontario
