

Here are the details for the coming 2019-2020 school year:

General Schedule

K'tonton, Gan and Aleph (Pre-School, Kindergarten and First grade) will meet on Sunday mornings from 9:30-12:30.

Bet- B'nai Mitzvah (2-7th grade) will meet on Sunday mornings 9:30-12:30 **and** Thursday afternoons from 4-6PM.

Youth and Family Shabbat Programming

Bet, Gimmel, Dalet, and Hei (2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade) will have 2 required Shabbat Family Education programs. These programs are already paid for through Hebrew School Tuition and are a part of Hebrew School. At least one adult should accompany your child(ren). When Family Education takes place, Hebrew School will not meet on Sunday. These Shabbat programs are open to all siblings and children in the whole synagogue community. Even if your child is not in 2-5th grade, no classes will meet on those Sundays.

These Youth and family Shabbatot are:

Saturday, March 21 (School will not meet Sunday, March 22)

Hebrew School Requirements by Grade

Hei (5th grade) will participate in the 4 Family Education listed above, **1 Sunday Family Education program and 8 Jr. Congregations.**

In addition to the 4 Family Education programs, 5th graders will join for 8 Keshet Family Services throughout the school year on Saturday morning. Services start at 11AM. Additionally, on Sunday, February 2, at least one adult and the 5th grader will join together for World Wide Wrap and then the B'nei Mitzvah Unrolling event. Both events will take place during Hebrew School hours.

Vav (6th grade) will participate in **3 Family Education B'nei Mitzvah programs with Rabbi Gold and 13 Saturday mornings.**

2. World Wide Wrap, Sunday, February 2 9:30-10:30AM
3. Saturday morning, March 21, 9:30AM-12:30PM

These programs are already paid for through Hebrew School Tuition and are a part of Hebrew School and the B'nei Mitzvah process. One adult should plan on joining your child(ren).

Students will attend thirteen Saturday morning services in the main service. Saturday morning services start at 9:30AM and the Torah services starts approximately at 10:00AM. Students are expected to “sticker-in” to document attendance and foster independence.

B'nei Mitzvah (7th Grade) will participate in **3 Family Education programs and 9 Saturday mornings.**

1. Friday night service and dinner with Rabbi Sebert on November 15
2. World Wide Wrap, Sunday, February 2 9:30-10:30AM
3. Saturday morning services and lunch with Cantor Postman, January 11, 9:30AM-1:30PM
4. Saturday morning services and lunch with Rabbi Gold April 25, 9:30-1:30PM

These programs are already paid for through Hebrew School Tuition and are a part of Hebrew School and the B'nei Mitzvah process. One adult should plan on joining your child(ren).

Students will attend nine Saturday morning services in the main service. Saturday morning services start at 9:30AM and the Torah services starts approximately at 10:00AM. Students are expected to “sticker-in” to document attendance and foster independence.

For Our Day School Families

We invite and encourage you to join for our 2 Youth and Family Shabbatot. We look forward to all of our Town & Village families joining together. If your child is in 6th or 7th grade, and participating in T&V's B'nei Mitzvah program, your family should join for those Family Education dates and follow the service requirements for those grades.

High School Students (9th grade and up)

1. Teen Program – a series of monthly dinners where students are pushed to think critically about the world in which they live, through a Jewish lens with Rabbi Gold and our Teen Coordinator.
2. USY Youth Group – a series of monthly engaging, fun activities for teens. Past events have included an escape room, game night and a sleep over at the synagogue.
3. Mitzvah Sundays - Each month, teens will engage in a mitzvah project .
4. Teen Teaching Assistants - Teens serve as teaching assistants for Hebrew School during the school year.
