Dear Member,

With the High Holidays approaching, it is time to renew your K.I.N.S. membership for 5782. Your membership dues are vital to help support the shul's ongoing operations and programs. We appreciate your ongoing support and partnership by renewing your K.I.N.S. membership for 5782. We are also excited about our recent opening of the K.I.N.S. North location and to welcoming more members to the K.I.N.S. family.

For 5782, membership dues and the security fee will remain the same as 5781. The shul's policy is that no member will be turned away because of a true financial hardship. If you need to speak to someone regarding a special financial arrangement for your membership dues, please contact me, Michael Perl or the president (Shelly Aberman). Contact information is available by contacting the office. To complete your renewal please fill out the enclosed 5782 Membership Dues and High Holiday Seating Request form or visit the shul's website at www.congkins.org. If you need help accessing your account on the Shul's website, please contact Shelly Aberman at president@congkins.org. The renewal procedures are outlined below.

1. Your 5782 membership will automatically activate in the same category as your 5781 membership, unless you contact the office to make a change. Enclosed is an invoice for your 5782 membership renewal.
2. For 5782 membership dues, all members **must** select one of three payment options: (1) payment in full, (2) payment in three equal installments, or (3) payment in ten equal installments. For all installment payment options, you must provide the Shul with a credit card number or post-dated checks for future installments for 5782 membership dues. All membership renewals can be done by accessing your account on the shul website (www.congkins.org/member) or by contacting the shul office.
3. We ask that everyone please contact the office and arrange for full payment or a payment plan no later than Monday, August 23, 2021. **Please note that High Holiday seats are not guaranteed and will only be assigned after all open balances, including past and present membership dues, have been satisfied in full, a payment plan has been made, or other payment arrangements have been agreed upon with the officers listed above.**
4. The planning for the High Holiday seating is underway. As in the past, the main K.I.N.S. location will be having two minyanim for the High Holidays, an early minyan which will meet in the Beit Midrash and the regular minyan which will meet in the main sanctuary. In addition, we are excited to add an additional minyan at the new K.I.N.S. North location.
5. As we have done in past years, we will have one combined Kol Nidre service for all minyanim at the main K.I.N.S. location, and this minyan will take place in the main sanctuary. Please note, for this minyan only there will be **no assigned seating**.

It is most helpful to our very busy office staff and to the seat-assignment committee if you submit your membership and seating requests as early as possible.
