SECURITY REMINDER

Our Shabbat/Yom Tov lock is located on the second door from the left of the main entrance. The lock will be accessible when there is no CSS team on duty. During this time, all other doors will be locked and access to the building will only be via the ShabbatYom Tov lock. Doors will only be unlocked on Shabbat when there is a security presence. Please do not prop doors open with items such as hangers.
