**Keynote speaker: Dr. Moshe Avital.** Our keynote speaker this year is Moshe Avital, who was born in Bilke, a village in eastern Czechoslovakia. In 1939, Moshe was taken to the Ghetto Berkhovo and then with his entire family to Auschwitz. Moshe endured transfers to six different camps and was eventually liberated at Buchenwald on April 11, 1945. Traveling illegally to Palestine, he joined the Haganah, and fought in the wars from 1947 to 1950 and in 1956. Moshe came to the U. S. to pursue his studies.
