#### A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

#### **UNANSWERED PRAYERS - PERSONAL RESOLVE**



Yaakov is overcome with fear as Eisav approaches with 400 men. He prays to Hashem:

ָהַצִּילַנִי נֵא מִיָּד אָחָי מִיָּד עֲשֶוֹ כֶּי־יַרָא אָנֹכִי אֹתוֹ פֶּרְ־יִבְוֹא וְהַכָּנִי אָם עַל־בָּנֵים: וְאָתָּה אָמַׁרְתָּ הִיטַב אֵיטֵיב עִמֶּךְ וְשַׂמְתֶּי אֱת־זַרְעָךְ כְּחָוֹל הַיָּם אֲשֵׁר לֹא־יִסְפֶּר מרב:

"Rescue me, please, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Eisav, for I fear that he will come and strike me down, mother and children. For did you not say, 'I will surely do good to you and

I will make your offspring like the sand of the sea which is too numerous to count.""

Before describing the gifts that Yaakov sends to his brother, the Torah says, "He slept there that night." Why does the Torah interrupt Yaakov preparations by telling us of his sleep? Rabbi David Kimchi (Radak) explains:

וולן שם, עומד ומצפה תשובת הקל על תפילתו

Hashem would communicate to Yaakov in his dreams. Yaakov attempted to gain guidance from Hashem by sleeping after his prayer. He was waiting for Hashem's answer to his prayer.

Yet, Hashem does not respond to him; at this crucial moment, no angels appear. The Torah seeks to communicate Yaakov's desperation to us. Yaakov awakes with his prayer unanswered.

Radak derives a crucial lesson, from Yaakov's resilience at this moment.

ולא בא לו המלאך שהיה תשובת תפלתו עד שהכין המנחה ושלחה לפניו, וזה להודיע כי האדם שהוא בעת צרה אפילו יהיה צדיק לא יסמוך על הנס אלא ישמור עצמו בכל אשר יכול

Yaakov gets up and keeps working. He does not allow a spiritual set back to delay his sending gifts to his brother. Yaakov at the verge of despair pushes forward.

Like Yaakov, we often feel that our attempts at prayer fall short. Like Yaakov, we too must grit our teeth and fight on. We acknowledge that angels don't depart and arrive based on our schedule. We feel this now – in this eit tzara. We await an answer to our many tefillot. Like Yaakov, we must continue to work, and we must continue to daven. May we learn from Yaakov's lesson.






