# A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

#### **BOUND TOGETHER**



Yehuda argues, "Binyamin must not be enslaved because separating him from his father would kill his father." (נָפָשׁוֹ קשׁוּרָה בָנָפְשׁוֹ

his own life is so bound up with his (44:30)

The Radak explains:

ונפשו קשורה בנפשו, מרוב אהבה ואם לא ישוב הנער אתנו תצא נפשו ותהיה האשמה רבה עלינו ועליך שסבבת את מיתתו.

And his soul is bound with his soul, out of great love. But if the young man does not return with us, his father's soul will depart, and great guilt will be upon us and upon you, as you have triggered his death.

This argument would not hold up in a Western court or for that matter in a *beit din*. Every person is responsible for his or her own actions.

לא־יוּמְתוּ אָבוֹת עַל־בָּנִים וּבְנִים לא־יוּמְתוּ עַל־אָבוֹת אִישׁ בְּחָטָאוֹ יוּמְתוּ Parents shall not be put to death for children, nor children be put to death for parents: they shall each be put to death only for their own crime. (Devarim 24:16)

Yet, Yehuda's plea for mercy suggests that the secondary impact of our well-being on those closest to us must be recognized. It may not be a legal consideration, but it must be a moral one. The appreciation and understanding of this morality is critical not just to Yehuda's argument – but also to the risk he takes on Binyamin's behalf. It is not just Yaakov and Binyamin whose souls are bound together; it is Yehuda's, too.

As we read these words this year, we feel them differently. As we awake to news of IDF casualties, we feel just how bound-up our lives are. As we feel the injustice of antisemitism and the cynical and cruel use of collective identity to tar all Jews within a modern blood libel, we feel how much our lives connect to one another.

Rabbi Hayyim Angel is the National Scholar of the Institute for Jewish Ideas and Ideals (jewishideas.org). With a primary focus on the interaction between traditional and academic approaches to Bible study, Rabbi Angel has taught to undergraduate, graduate, and rabbinical students at Yeshiva University since 1996, and lectures widely in synagogues and schools throughout North America. He has authored or edited twenty books, his most recent being "Psalms: A Companion Volume (Kodesh Press, 2022)", and has published over 150 scholarly articles. He is editor of Conversations, the journal of the Institute for Jewish Ideas and Ideals, and serves on the editorial boards of Tradition and Megadim. Rabbi Angel previously served as Rabbi of Congregation Shearith Israel in New York City (1995-2013), and as Rabbinic Scholar at Congregation Kehilath Jeshurun in New York (2014-2017). He received his B.A. in Jewish studies Summa cum Laude from Yeshiva College, his M.A. in Bible from the Bernard Revel Graduate School, his M.S. in Jewish Education from the Azrieli Graduate School of Jewish Education, and his Rabbinical Ordination from the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary of Yeshiva University. He lives in Teaneck, New Jersey with his wife and four children
