### A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

The Rabbi Sacks Legacy Trust is inviting one new voice per week to



illuminate the ideas of Rabbi Jonathan Sacks and encourage others to continue his conversations with the next generation. This week, that voice is mine.

Rabbi Sacks told the following story:

A crowd of people gathered on a hill by the sea to watch a great ship pass by. A young child is waving enthusiastically. One of the

men in the crowd asks him why. He says, "I am waving so the captain of the ship can see me and wave back." The man responds, "But the ship is far away, and there is a large crowd of us here. What makes you think that the captain can see you?" The boy answers, "He will be looking for me among the crowd. The captain of the ship is my father."

Rabbi Sacks saw a connection between this story and birchat kohanim's, "May the Lord turn His face toward you." The fact is that we are all God's children. He is our parent. He turns His face toward us. He cares."

Three days before my elder son's bar mitzvah (parshat Naso five years ago), I was seriously injured in a bicycle accident. I received amazing support from my family, friends, doctors, and community – prayers from around the world – and most importantly a *refuah sheleimah* from Hashem.

During my recovery, I picked up an unexpected call. Rabbi Sacks was on the line. He was calling to check on how I was doing. He wanted to give me his blessing. The call was short. The heavens did not suddenly break open with blinding light. Yet, I still felt like the boy on the seashore waving at the boat. The captain had seen me.

Rabbi Sacks' essay this week relates to our faith in Hashem, "We matter as individuals because God cares for us as a parent for a child." The vehicle through which we experience that blessing is human – the Kohanim stand up and bless the community. As Rabbi Sacks demonstrated, we can each be that priest or captain in the lives of those around us – by noticing them and sharing kind words and blessings with them.

Last month, the Surgeon General set out plans to combat a health crisis named Loneliness. It's not an easy feeling to overcome. But when we feel Hashem's face turned toward us, we know that we are not alone. And when people connect to us, we are not alone. When we don the captain's hat and reach out with a loving wave, we too are not alone.

Ringt Yoetzet Nechama Price is the Director of Yeshiva University's Graduate Program for Advanced Talmud Studies (GPATS), from which she earned certification in 2003. She is a Senior Lecturer in the Bible and Judaic Studies departments at Stern College, where she has been teaching since 2004. Nechama earned a master's degree in Jewish Education from Azrieli Graduate School, and an MA in Bible from the Bernard Revel Graduate School. She is also a graduate of the inaugural class of the American branch of Nishmat's Yoetzet Halacha Program, and currently serves as a Yoetzet Halacha (Halakhic Advisor) to the communities of Teaneck, Englewood, Tenafly, Livingston, West Orange, and Long Branch NJ. Nechama recently published her first book, Tribal Blueprints, analyzing the lives and personalities of the twelve tribes. Nechama is a community scholar and speaks all over North America. She and her husband and family live in Bergenfield, NJ.

"ART AS WITNESS: THE WORK AND REMARKABLE SURVIVAL STORY OF ESTHER LURIE."

The survival story of celebrated artist Esther Lurie (1913-1998), the only Israeli artist to win the prestigious Dizengoff Prize for Drawing twice in her career, was beyond remarkable. After she made Alivah and had established herself as a prominent artist in young Tel Aviv, Lurie was caught up in the claws of the Hitlerite monster, while visiting her sister. From that point on, she was driven by two motivations – to survive the Kovna Ghetto and a number of labor camps, and to bear witness to Nazi crimes, through a series of brilliant, clandestine sketches and illustrations.

The grandson of Holocaust survivors who immigrated to Israel from the USSR about a decade after the founding of the Jewish State, Dr. Pilnik is the Director of the Emil and Jenny A. Fish Center for Holocaust and Genocide Studies at Yeshiva University. Prior to becoming the Fish Center's founding Director, he was the Executive Director of the Nathan and Esther Pelz Holocaust Education Resource Center (HERC) in Milwaukee between 2014 and 2020.


