A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

THE STRUCTURE OF COMMUNITY



Shabbat 116A explains that *sefer bamidbar* is in fact three books:

ּתָּנוֹ רְבָּנָן: "וְיָהִי בָּנְסוֹעַ הָאָרוֹן וִיּאמֶר מֹשֶׁה" — פָּרְשָׁה זוֹ עָשָׂה לְהַ הַקְּדוֹשׁ בָּרוֹךְ הוּא סִימָנִיּוֹת מִלְמעלָה וּלְמְטָה, לוֹמֵר שְׁאִין זֶה מְקוֹמָהּ. רָבִּי אוֹמֵר: לֹא מִן הַשָּׁם הוּא זֶה, אֶלָּא מִפְּנֵי שָׁסֶפְר חָשׁוּב הוּא בַּפְּנֵי עַצֵּמוֹ.

Rebbi's explanation divides sefer bamidbar between the organizing of the camp in parshiyot bamidbar, naso and

behalotecha and the narrative sections of national failure that begin at the end of parshat behalotecha. Rebbi highlights the traveling of the aron set off with backward nuns, which is positioned between these two sections. As we begin sefer bamidbar, I'd like to reflect on the first book.

Blockbuster movies often have a common element: a loud and exciting destruction sequence. Heroes, robots, or aliens destroy cars, buildings, and cities, as they pursue sometimes beneficial but often nefarious ends. As we watch these "fireworks," we rarely consider the effort that went into these fictional sets or the worlds they represent.

Building is slow and boring. Destruction is often quick and exciting. This is true not just for physical edifices, but also for social and political structures. Convincing people to work together is difficult. Building trust in a relationship, in a community, or in a society require thousands of rules-based interactions that reinforce positive habits.

Sefer Bamidbar is a tale of construction and de-construction. The stories of meraglim and adat korach are exciting narratives with heroes and anti-heroes. Yet, the field upon which they work their damage must first be painstakingly constructed in our parsha. Many are the names and numbers of people who must work together to direct the Jewish people through the desert. They constitute a hierarchy of leaders and families, which constitute the structure of national life.

A large number of people can only move based on rules and laws – their cooperation cannot be taken for granted. I thought about this challenge during the months of work to put together our community's Yom Haatzmaut celebration. I think about it when I watch the destruction on the news. Community is built upon boring but positive habits like weekly "shabbat shalom"s and "thank you"s to volunteers and donors. We can only expect others to constrain themselves, if we are prepared to constrain ourselves. We can only expect others to be quiet when our child's name is called out at a graduation, if we are prepared to be quiet when their child's name is called. As we labor through "the numbers" in our parsha, let us consider what it takes for a society to come together. Let's not take these structures for granted. Let's appreciate this "book" of positive numbers and let us recognize books like it, that we might still write.


