A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER**RIVKA'S JOURNEY AND OUR JOURNEY**

In an essay in his book *Nekudat Peticha*, Rav Amnon Bazak tracks many textual and thematic parallels between Rivka and Avraham. Avraham wasn't the only person who left his family and his home to travel to *eretz yisrael*. *Parshat chaye sarah* recounts Rivka's journey from Haran to Canaan. This was the

very same journey that Avraham took in *parshat lech lecha*. In Rivka's case, her journey was prompted by a visit from Avraham's servant seeking a wife for Yitzchak. After describing his test of Rivka's kindness, the Torah goes to great lengths to explain how he convinces Rivka's family to send their daughter and sister to marry Avraham's son. Significantly, the Torah emphasizes that Rivka herself (and not her parents) made the final decision to travel to Canaan and to leave her home behind.

The journey to *eretz yisrael* becomes a recurring theme in the Torah. Avraham, Rivka, Rachel, Leah, and one day all the Jewish people would be required to choose Israel. Rivka's decision displays courage – perhaps even beyond that of Avraham. Avraham travels with family, i.e. his wife and his nephew. Rivka travels with a stranger presenting himself as Avraham's messenger. Avraham travels with the command of Hashem; Rivka travels with a culture of *chesed* – a belief that her care for Avraham's servant indicates something about her destiny. With every generation, our forefathers and foremothers had to choose to break away from the past and commit themselves to the mission of our people. They had to bring themselves to the land of Israel. We too must commit ourselves anew to this mission and to this land. This is true especially this year when Israel is under attack. The Zionism of every generation requires new choices. As we celebrate Rivka's courage, let us ask ourselves, "When are we prepared to follow in her footsteps?"

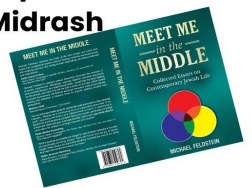

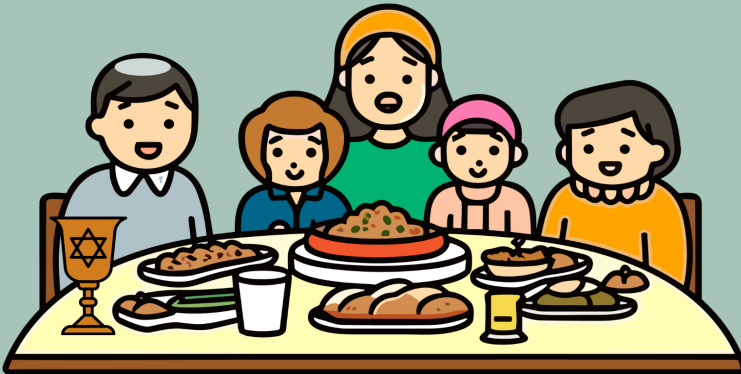
