A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

THE FORGIVEN AND THE FORCED



At our *tzarich iyun* program this past *motzai shabbat*, we discussed two versions of the famous Golda Meir quote:

"When peace comes we will perhaps in time be able to forgive the Arabs for killing our sons, but it will be harder for us to forgive them for having forced us to kill their sons."

"I can forgive the Arabs for sending their boys to kill our boys, but I can never forgive them for forcing us to send our boys to become killers." Do you know which version is correct? Answer: The first.

It came from a press conference in London (1969), as quoted in A Land of Our Own: An Oral Autobiography (1973) edited by Marie Syrkin, p. 242. During the *tzarich iyun* program, we spoke about the importance of nuance in the words that we use to identify ourselves. Our boys are not killers. They are – הרחמנים, והביִשנין, וגוֹמְלִי חָסְדִים merciful, modest and kind (Yevamot 78A). Yes – in war, our boys must fight and they do kill – yet this never becomes their essential character.

Rav Shimshon Rephael Hirsch relates to this question of our people's identity when speaking about Yaakov Avinu in *parshat vayeitze* (29:10). He speaks about three elements of Yaakov's person: his strength, his sense of justice, and his work ethic.

In this story, we find what father Yaakov took with him to build his future. He didn't have much money. The most obvious thing he had was his strength. What others had to come together to do, he did alone, and without any effort... This strong, healthy body was his only material wealth, for now. A treasure that cannot be valued enough, ... it can only be acquired through a purely lived past... Secondly, he had an unshakable sense of justice. Just like Moshe, who also found his future at the well, Yaakov would not tolerate the slightest neglect of duty. A loyalty to duty that he later demonstrated so brilliantly even in the most difficult of service situations. Thirdly, a work -loving ethic that he uses even where it is not his business, which we would not have expected from the איש הם יושב אהלים. Yaakov thus appears as a real prototype of the people of which he was to become the progenitor, and which was destined to represent the most diverse, material and spiritual professional activities with equal dignity and equality. The progenitor had such versatility that each of his sons could say that he had inherited his characteristic ability from his father, who was equally perfect in teaching, nurturing and defense.

At a time of rising antisemitism, Rav Hirsch's words should serve to inspire us. In the words that we use to describe ourselves, we must never unconsciously adopt our enemies' hateful propaganda. To be a Jew is to be strong, just and hard-working. To be a Jew is to be merciful, modest and kind. Let us thank Hashem for the privilege of being children of Yaakov. Let us take great pride in the heroic actions of our sons (and daughters).
