A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

The Good Tzaraat



Should we desire to live in a world with tzaraat?

Perhaps we should.

Tzaraat can afflict not just of a person but also his or her clothing. Commenting on this detail, Rabbi Ovadia Sforno appreciated the unnatural character of this spiritual disease:

אין ספק בו שלא יהיה זה בטבע בשום פנים, כי בבגד לא יקרו אלה המראות המשונות...

It is quite clear that this is not the kind of stain familiar to nature for such strange stains cannot happen to clothing...

He suggests that the reality of tzaraat is a blessing from Hashem.

אמנם העיד הכתוב שלפעמים יהיה זה כפלא בבגדים ובבתים, וזה להעיר אוזן הבעלים על עבירות שבידם... וכל זה בחמלת ה' על עמו.

The phenomenon of white garments or exterior walls of houses which are normally whitewashed breaking out in different colors is by itself a warning to the owner to examine his lifestyle and what he might have done wrong to rate such a warning... Proof of the fact that this affliction is due to a well-meaning Creator, One Who is concerned with the welfare of His people.

The Sforno notes that these laws of tzaraat apply only to Jews – as a counterintuitive reflection of blessing. To live a life of spiritual sensitivity might mean suffering certain warnings – but we are ultimately better for it.

In his recent book, The Anxious Generation, Jonathan Haidt applies a similar idea to parenting. A child who is protected from all pain and difficulty will grow up dependent and fragile. A child who must struggle (at times) can become independent and antifragile. As we read parshat tazria, let us aspire to a lost spiritual sensitivity with all its attendant problems. As we look to our world with all its tragedy and pain, let us see the beauty in how a life of challenge can shape our and our children's characters for the good.
