# A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

**TOGETHER IN THE HARD TIMES** 



Lessons from failure are often more important than lessons from success.

Rashi records a conversation between Moshe and Aharon during the moments before *Hashem's* presence descended upon the *mishkan*:

When Aharon perceived that all the sacrifices had been offered and all the rites performed, and yet the Shechinah had not descended for Israel, since the heavenly fire had not fallen to consume the sacrifice, he was uneasy in mind and said: I feel certain that the Holy One, blessed be He, is angry with me and that it is on my account that the Shechinah has not descended for Israel. He therefore said to Moshe: "My brother Moshe! Do you act thus with me: you know that I have entered into this matter at your bidding and yet I have been put to shame! Moshe at once entered the tent with him and they offered prayer and the Shechinah descended for Israel (Rashi 9:23).

The window into the brotherly relationship of Aaron and Moshe is both sensitive and surprisingly human. Moshe will not indulge his brother's self-accusations. He instead turns him forward to the *mishkan* and joins him in his moment of "shame." Moshe helps Aharon focus on the future turning a moment of despair into a moment of hope.

Like Aharon, each of us has moments where we feel that we have failed. Like Moshe, we each have the opportunity to assist when others face despair. May we merit to draw on relationships that draw out the best in us – showing one another a path to hope.
