A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER**SO DO IT**

כָּל־אֲשֶׁר אֲנִי מֵרָאֶה אוֹתָךְ אֶת תְּבִנָּת הַמִּשְׁכָּן וְאֶת תְּבִנָּת כָּל־כֵּלָיו וְכֵן תַּעֲשֶׂה:

Like everything that I show you, the form of the Tabernacle and the form of all its vessels; and so shall you do.

Hashem tells Moshe to build a *mishkan* in which Hashem's presence will dwell. The Torah adds the words, "and so shall you do" – a seemingly superfluous phrase.

Rashi explains:

וכן תעשו. לדורות (סנהדרין ט"ז), אם יאבד אחד מן הכלים, או כשתעשו לי כלי בית עולמים, כגון שלחנות ומנורות וכירות ומכונות שעשה שלמה, כתבנית אליו תעשו אותם...

The Torah anticipates the maintenance and expansion needs of the *mikdash*. A vessel might get lost and a new one would need to be constructed. Shlomo would build a larger *beit hamikdash*, and the model of these vessels would be used in building knew vessels for that Temple.

Ramban challenges Rashi's claim that all future construction would take the form of the original design:

ולא ידעתי שיהיה זה אמת שיתחייב שלמה לעשות כלי בית עולמים כתבנית אלו

He offers the *beit hamikdash* as an example of new designs being employed. Ramban explains the words so shall you do it as a verbal prompt to get the job done right away.

וכן תעשו כולכם בזריות וחריצות

Remarkably, according to both Rashi and Ramban, the Torah does not see the act of building a *mishkan* as a one-time experience. Rather, the process of maintaining the most basic materials of Jewish life would require constant updating. Nothing lasts forever in its physical form. From the outset of the *mishkan*'s construction, the Torah acknowledges that we must act to recreate the elements of the *mishkan* to ensure its continuity.

This is true for the physical sanctuaries that we call our spiritual homes. We must ask ourselves, "Are they in good shape; are we keeping them up to date?" But, we must also think about the *mishkanot* that exist within our hearts. We should seek opportunities for continuing Jewish learning and growth to further our spiritual selves. This *parshat terumah*, please review the many shiurim and classes available to us in Teaneck and find something that can renew the *mishkan* within your heart.

I will be away this Shabbat in Israel in advance of the Bergen County Mission which will take place, next week. I will join a strong Rinat contingent in representing our community in supporting Israel and its people during this eit tzara. We hope to bring back encouraging stories and messages from Israel's heroes. Wishing you a Shabbat Shalom.

Rabbi Dr. Shlomo Brody is the executive director of Ematai, an organization dedicated to helping Jews navigate dilemmas regarding aging, end-of-life treatment, and organ donation. He previously served as a rebbe at Yeshivat Hakotel, the dean of the Tikvah Online Academy, and a research fellow at the Israel Democracy Institute. A columnist for *The Jerusalem Post*, his writings have appeared in many popular and scholarly publications and were cited in Israeli Supreme Court decisions. He is the author of *Ethics of Our Fighters: A Jewish View on War and Morality* (Maggid) and *A Guide to the Complex: Contemporary Halakhic Debates* (Maggid), a National Jewish Book Award winner. A graduate of Harvard College, he received rabbinic ordination from the Israeli Chief Rabbinate, an MA in Jewish philosophy at the Hebrew University, and his PhD from Bar Ilan University Law School.
