A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

Pekudei 5784



MISHKAN MISHKAN

Parshat Pekudei begins with a grand pronouncement regarding the *mishkan*:

אֵלֶּה פְּקֻדֵּי הַמִּשְׁכָּן מִשְׁכַּן הָעֵדֻת אֲשֶׁר פָּקַד עַל־פִּי מֹשֶׁה ...

These are the records of the Tabernacle, the Tabernacle of Testimony, which were drawn up at Moses' bidding... (38:21)

The doubling of the word *mishkan* troubles the commentaries. Ibn Ezra explains the first use of *mishkan* as referring to all the contents of the Tabernacle. The second use of the word *mishkan* – *mishkan haedut* – refers to the central role of the *aron* and the *luchot haedut* in defining the *mishkan*.

Rashi offers a somewhat disheartening explanation. The doubling of the word *mishkan* hints to the destruction of the two *batei mikdash*.

שְׁנֵי פָעִמִּים, רָמַז לְמִקְדָּשׁ שֶׁנִּתְמַשְׁכָּן בְּשָׁנֵי חֲרָבָיו עַל עֲוֹנוֹתֵיהֶן שֶׁל יִשְׂרָאֵל

In offering this explanation (based on Midrash Tanchuma), Rashi also creatively retranslates the word *mishkan* as *mashkon* – collateral. The *mishkan* would serve as a means of expiation for the sins of the Jewish people – not simply in allowing sin-offerings to be brought – but also in its eventual destruction in the form of *churban habayit*. The *mishkan* becomes a testimony to the forgiveness of the Jewish people for *chet haegel* – while also serving as a physical substitute for the Jewish people when they would sin again.

At its outset, the *mishkan's* destruction is built-in to its very design; it is collateral. This should not sadden us. The *mishkan* is a means for Hashem's ongoing relationship with the Jewish people and not an end unto itself. As we think of its dramatic inauguration at the conclusion of our *parsha*, we too should think of our relationship with Hashem and the many tools and collaterals that enable it. We must rejoice in them while recognizing that they are not ultimately the goal of our religious life.
