A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER**MOST IMPORTANT MOMENTS**

I meet with couples before their weddings to discuss good marital habits. I ask what is the most important moment of the day for your relationship. I get very different answers. What's my answer? It is the moment before the door to a home opens and a couple face each other for the first time at the end of a long day. So

much is communicated when we see each other for that first time. Do we bring into the house all the toil and frustration of our work lives, or do we exhibit the relief and satisfaction that now we can enjoy the fruits of what we have been working for all day? Are we passing through our lives filling roles (husband, wife, father, or mother) or are we fully present in the love that we feel for one another? The moment when we first look at each other sets the tone for everything that will follow that evening.

We begin a new book of the Torah, this week. The book begins with Hashem's first call to Moshe from the *mishkan* that the Jewish people have just dedicated. First words matter.

Rashi focuses on the choice of words for that first call, *Vayikra*:

לְכָל דְבָרוֹת וּלְכָל אֲמִירוֹת וּלְכָל צְוִיִּים קִדְמָה קְרִיאָה, לְשׁוֹן חִבָּה, לְשׁוֹן שְׂמֵלָאֲכִי הַשָּׂרָת מִשְׁתַּמְשִׁין בּוֹ, שֶׁנֶּאֱמַר וְקָרָא זֶה אֵל זֶה

All oral communications of the Lord to Moses whether they are introduced by לָבַד or by אָמַר or by יָצַ were preceded by a call (to prepare him for the forthcoming address). It is a way of expressing affection, the mode used by the ministering angels when addressing each other, as it is said (Isaiah 6:3)

Rashi notes that the word *vayikra* is *lashon chibah* – beckoning someone out of love. As if to say, come to me. Hashem addresses us from a place of love – seeking to give us the opportunity to live a life of meaning contained in the *mitzvot* that Hashem will soon instruct Moshe. How we feel about our religious lives matters. Do we perceive the commandments with which we direct our lives as emerging from a place of *chibah* – love?

As a rabbi and father, I often attend *siddur* presentations and *hanachat tefillin*. It inspires for me to see the excitement on the children's faces as they are about to receive their own *siddur* or lay *tefillin* for the first time. The children are overcome with emotion. The children's excitement and love expresses a value of our community. We love our Judaism. When we open our *siddur* and hear Hashem's call every morning, may we always feel this love.

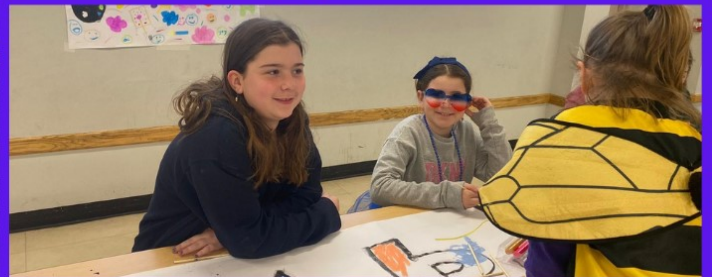
