A MESSAGE FROM RABBI STRAUCHLER

REPLACING MOSHE



The eigel hazahav is a profoundly disturbing and perplexing story. What motivated the people to seek idolatry when Moshe did not return as expected? How could Aharon be party to this sin by making a golden calf for the people?

Ibn Ezra and Ramban both explain that the people did not seek a replacement for Hashem. Rather, the people sought a replacement for Moshe. Ibn Ezra explains that the word *elohim*, in the phrase "come let us make for ourselves *elohim*," does not mean gods, ומלת אלהים כבוד חונה בצורת גויה

The word elohim means honor that rests in the form of a body.

The people needed a focal point to give them direction. They needed an outlet for their spiritual energies – a place for their hopes and their worries. The Ramban explains,

היו מבקשין משה אחר

The people sought another Moshe.

Moshe, as leader of the people, had served as that focal point for their spiritual energies and hopes. He may not have been worshipped – but he gave meaning, purpose, and direction to his people's lives.

Despite these justifications, the creation of the *eigel* was profoundly wrong. In explaining the people's motivation, Ibn Ezra and Ramban bring the story closer to our own lives. We miss the relevance of the *eigel* if we read the people's motivation as mere pagan irrationality and senseless hedonism. We are no different from our ancestors when we seek a focus for our energies in pursuing potentially false purposes for our lives (in the form of a human idol or otherwise). As we read *parshat ki tissa*, let us ask ourselves, "Are we creating an *elohim* in place of Moshe and his Torah?" The possibility that such creations might be "close" to our religious norms should push us to rededicate ourselves that much more completely to a constant and careful focus upon Hashem, and Hashem alone.


