## When Davening from Home

- 1 – Kaddish, Borchu and Kedusha are not recited when davening at home.
- 2 – The prayer of Brich Shemei is not recited. Omit the second Yekum Purkan and the following Mi Shebeirach.
- 3 – It is best to review the weekly portion (Bamidbar)It is also best to read the Haftorah (Haftorah for the Shabbat immediately preceding Rosh Chodesh "Machar Chodesh").
- 4 – Anim Zemiroth is not recited when davening alone.
- 5 – Count the Omer after dark.
- 6 - This week we recite Birchat HaChodesh for the month of Sivan. Rosh Chodesh is Sunday. The molad is Friday 42 minutes and 13 chalakim after 11, Jerusalem Sundial time. Av HaRachamim is recited after Birchat HaChodesh for the month of Sivan.**
- 7 – Inster Yaaleh V'Yavo in the Amidah on Motzai Shabbat, and for Shacharit and Mincha on Sunday. Additionally, on Sunday morning half Hallel and Musaf is also recited.**
