Section F - Footstone Required, Headstone not permitted 24”x12” standard granite footstone, 4 “max front height, 6” max rear height	\$ 1,200.00
Section G – Headstone and/or Footstone Required	\$ 2,000.00

Mowing and basic cleanup is included for all Menorah Section purchases.
Endowed Care can be contracted directly from East Ridgelawn Cemetery.

King Solomon Memorial Park Section of West Ridgelawn Cemetery

Mt. Hermon II, # 2 – Footstone Only Required \$ 1,200.00

King Solomon Cemetery regulations specify that all footstones shall be bronze plaques on granite bases (of various sizes) with a max front height of 4”, max rear height of 6”

Permanent Care is included for King Solomon purchases consisting of mowing, cleaning, trimming, and weeding.

For all Sales:

- Plots are available for sale to members in good standing of Congregation Agudath Israel and their family.
- The family relationship extends to 1) the immediate family of that CAI member including parents, current or former spouses, siblings, and children, AND 2) the immediate family of those mentioned above including parents, current or former spouses, siblings, and children.
- Plots may only be used for the burial of Jews.
- Infant sized plots are available in the Menorah Cemetery for purchase at 50% of the current rates above.
- The Association will buy back any unused plots at their original purchase price.
- All sales are subject to the rules and regulations of the CAI Cemetery Association and each individual cemetery.
