

VOTING MADE EASY

MAIL BALLOTS: All eligible voters in New Jersey can vote by mail ballot in the November general election. Here is essential information about deadlines and procedures:

1. **September 19, 2020:** Vote-by-mail ballots will be sent to uniformed and overseas voters.
2. **October 5, 2020:** Deadline for ballots being mailed by county clerks to domestic voters.
3. **October 13, 2020:** Deadline to register to vote for November election.
4. **October 23, 2020:** Deadline for newly registered voters to apply for a vote-by-mail ballot.
5. **November 3, 2020 (Election Day):** Mail-in-ballots must be postmarked.
6. **8:00 pm November 10, 2020:** Mail-in-ballots must be received in the County Clerk's Office, or placed in "Drop Boxes." You may also bring your mail-in-ballot to polling places on Election Day.

*** Due to anticipated postal delays, vote-by-mail ballots sent through the Postal Service should be mailed by **October 22, 2020.**

More drop box locations may be added; check with your County Clerk's Office.

IN-PERSON VOTING: You may also vote in person at your polling place. If you vote in person, you will be asked to vote *using a paper provisional ballot*. These ballots will be checked against ballots received by mail. No sample ballots will be sent.

VERIFICATION: You can verify that your ballot was received and processed by going to your County Clerk's website.
