AN ISRAELI NAVY SEAL (“M”) IN DIALOGUE WITH RABBI ARI LUCAS

Join us for the extraordinary story of an American who left his university to join the Israel Defense Forces and ultimately became part of one of the most elite units in the IDF, the Israeli Navy SEALs. Each year, 20,000 young men try out and 40 or fewer are ultimately selected to serve in Shayetet-13, the Israeli Navy SEALs. This rare American-born Israeli Navy SEAL joins Rabbi Ari Lucas to discuss his personal journey, serving in this elite and storied unit, its strict moral calculus, and how he uses the skills he learned on active duty in his daily civilian life.
