Potluck Policy

In order to engender a sense of community at Temple Beth El, we are planning, during the Festival of Sukkot, and periodically on Shabbat, pot luck meals. Meals brought in must be Kosher Style Dairy or Parve (non-meat, non-dairy, non-poultry) and be marked as such. Pot luck meals will be limited to the former criteria. No pot luck meals will take place during life cycle events at Temple Beth El. Rabbi Micah or a member of the Ritual Committee will have final decision on whether a food item meets the criteria. The TBE Kitchen and Social Hall are not to be used for these Pot-Luck Dinners. In case of inclement weather, the dinners will take place in Religious School Wing. Food will be set up in Multi-Purpose Room on Special Tables and eating will taking place in classrooms. Our subcommittee is poised to conduct a congregational survey and continue a more comprehensive review of our kashrut guidelines.
