#### FROM THE RABBI

I hope that we are all looking forward to celebrating Thanksgiving as the important day that it is on the American calendar. There is wide ranging discussion among contemporary Jewish poskim and halachists about how Jews should (or should not) mark the holiday. I will be devoting the Shabbat afternoon class this week to this topic. I will show my hand right here and point out something that I saw only recently that impacts my approach to the holiday.

When our matriarch Leah gave birth to her fourth (and final) child, she said "Now I thank (odeh) God...and therefore will call him Judah (Yehudah)." The name Yehudah derives from the same root as odeh (and the same root as the familiar "todah – thank you"). We are Jews/Yehudim because of Judah/Yehudah. Offering thanks is part of our DNA, as it were. In fact, Jews have ritualized saying thank you by offering blessings. When we offer the morning blessings (Artscroll page 18) we are saying thank you to God for, among other things, enabling us to open our eyes, stand up straight, put our feet on the floor, have clothing to wear. When we say a blessing before eating we are thanking God for the food we are about to consume. When we say the Bircat Hamazon – Grace After Meals, we thank God again for the food provided by God's benevolence.

We Jews are a thanking people. We should always thank God above for our many blessings. We should also be thankful for the people who love and support us in everything (or almost everything) we do.

Best wishes to all for a wonderful and meaningful Thanksgiving. Shabbat starts the next night...so Shabbat Shalom to you.
