Many have asked how we can truly celebrate Chanukah when our brothers and sisters in our homeland are at war. One approach can be to focus on the historical message of the holiday, as encapsulated in the popular Maoz Tzur. The poem-song focuses on the various kingdoms and peoples that at one time or another had it in for the Jews. Egypt. Babylon. Persia. Greece. Rome. They each were dominant world powers at different times. They were all guilty of anti-semitism and of persecuting the Jews in various horrible ways.

But in the end, none of them remained a dominant force in the world, but the Jewish People and the Land of Israel have managed to rise to their feet time and time again. We were down but never out. The same cannot be said of the other once mighty countries listed in the song. We have outlasted them all. May that be so in the future, as well.
