From the Rabbi ...



On Saturday, March 4, 2017, at 5:15 pm, Maya Friedman, the daughter of Brian and Dana Friedman, celebrated her Bat Mitzvah in our Sanctuary surrounded by her family and many friends. In many ways, this was a typical Bat Mitzvah – months of preparation and learning with the Cantor, explaining and chanting of prayers, a d'var Torah, words of blessing from her parents and the Rabbi, beaming grandparents and smiling family and attendees. But this Bat Mitzvah was actually anything but typical.

Maya is the first BMH-BJ Bat Mitzvah celebrant to have marked her entry into Jewish adulthood by reading from the Torah at a full Shabbat Mincha service conducted in a partnership style. A "Partnership Service" is a creative, innovative way to enhance the opportunities for women to participate in synagogue ritual life while following progressive *halachik* parameters. It is a full service (in this case,

Mincha) with a mechitza demarcating not only the sections for men's and women's seating, but also for where women and men stand at the reading table. It is not egalitarian in the common sense of the term but it is what might be called "halachickally" egalitarian. Men and women lead the parts of the service that traditional halacha (law) allows them to lead. That means men recite the parts called "devarim shebikedusha," the parts that absolutely require a minyan, like kaddish and kedusha, and women can lead sections such as introductory prayers, the Torah service along with various honors, and, yes, the reading of the Torah. Although still a relatively new innovation, there are a growing number of communities in the United States and Canada that offer this wonderful opportunity for various occasions. A well-known synagogue in the German Colony neighborhood of Jerusalem, Shira Chadasha, conducts all of its services this way.


Within the guidelines described above, Maya led the Mincha service in conjunction with Cantor Lichterman. She read from the Torah as her father and grandfather took *aliyot* and stood beside her. She delivered a wonderful *d'var Torah* about the importance of seeing the larger significance of easily overlooked moments. Men and women sat in their own sections of the sanctuary. A special energy filled the room.

It remains to be seen what effect Partnership Services will have on orthodox Jewish life, long term. But I fully support this effort to embrace ritual opportunities for women while remaining true to progressive halachik parameters. Mazal tov – and thank you – to the entire Friedman family, for allowing their milestone occasion to become a milestone achievement for our entire congregation.



The Cantor's Notes

The Four Questions We Should Ask Before Pesach

It's no secret that the number "four" plays a significant role all through Pesach, and especially during the Seder. For instance, Pesach is known by four names:



- 1. Pesach Passover since God "passed over" Jewish homes while implementing the 10th plague (death of the first born).
- 2. The festival of "matzah" (chag hamatzot)
- 3. The festival of "spring" (chag ha-aviv)
- 4. The season of freedom (z'man cheiruteinu)

Numerous Seder rituals were created and expanded upon, with the number four as their basis: the four "cups" of wine, the children's four "questions," the four "types and characteristics" of the children attending the Seder, and so on.

Many of us have surely asked the typical four pre-Pesach questions:

- 1. Who shall we invite to join us at our Seder?
- 2. Who will invite us to join their Seder?
- 3. What shall we eat?
- 4. Could we take a Pesach vacation and entrust the "destination management," in other words someone else with our Pesach needs?

May I propose another set of four pre-Pesach questions for your consideration:

- 1. How will this Seder differ from all past Sedarim we have hosted?
- 2. How will we create a new family custom this year?
- 3. Might we introduce a new food choice to the traditional menu, served unfailingly every year?
- 4. Could we learn a new Haggadah or Passover song and teach it to our family and guests at the Seder?


Although *minhag avoteinu* b'yadeinu ("previous generations' customs are ours"), I feel that they should be enhanced and embellished with our own imprimatur. In so doing, we embrace them, and having true ownership, set the stage for the next generation to love, appreciate, and perhaps practice.

Pesach celebrates the birth of the Jewish nation. The Haggadah encourages, in fact urges us, to view ourselves each year as having personally experienced the Exodus. I believe that we're being asked to "renew ourselves" each year by adding to our collective experiences new, exciting, and fresh dimensions. How else to do so other than asking of ourselves a new set of questions!

To quote the characters who are the cast of the TV show Shark Tank: "Do you accept the challenge? Are you in or are you out?"

Elaine, Justin, Philippa, Jakub, Eitan, Asher, Lori, and Dalia wish you a Chag Sameach v'Kasher. Enjoy a wonderful and uplifting Pesach.

By signing this convenient Statement of Authorization our clergy uses this power of attorney to sell your chametz. Use the form below to authorize the sale of your chametz. 
Delegation of Power of Attorney – Passover 2017

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Chaitovsky to act in my place and stead and in my behalf to sell all chametz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by The Torah and Rabbinic Law (e.g. chametz, doubt of chametz and all kind of chametz mixtures, chametz that tends to harden and to adhere to the inside surface of pans, pots or cooking and usable utensils and all kinds of live animals that have been eating chametz or mixtures thereof,) and to lease all places wherein the chametz owned by me may be found, especially in the premises located at the address(es) below and elsewhere.

Rabbi Chaitovsky has the full right to sell and to lease by transactions, as he deems fit and proper and for such time which he believes necessary in accordance with all detailed terms and detailed forms as explained in the general authorization contracts which have been give this year to Rabbi Chaitovsky to sell the chametz. This general authorization is made a part of this agreement. Also I hereby give Rabbi Chaitovsky full power and authority to appoint a substitute in his stead with full power to sell and to lease as provided herein. The above given power is in conformity with all Torah, Rabbinical regulations and laws and also in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado and of the United States. And to this I hereby affix my signature on this day of April, 2017.


