# Rabbinical Reflection: The Book Of Life

Herman Wouk, the acclaimed Jewish American novelist and playwright, author of The Caine Mutiny, Winds of War, War and Remembrance, Marjorie Morningstar and many other highly regarded works, passed away recently at the age of 104.

Did you know that Herman Wouk was a passionate, committed, devoutly Orthodox Jew? Many years ago, he wrote a different sort of book. It was a deeply personal reflection on Judaism and Jewish living. It was called This is My God, and to this day, it remains one of the most intelligent and readable introductions to Judaism available.

The High Holy Days are upon us. I want to share a small excerpt from the book that deals with the overarching theme of the Yamim Noraim – teshuvah, repentance. Here it is:

The past can be cancelled by a true cry from the heart to G-d and a return to His law. This holds not only for the annual reckoning, but to the last hour a man lives; so my grandfather taught me.


He had in his Bronx apartment a lodger less learned than himself, and much fiercer in piety.

One day when we were studying the laws of repentance together, the lodger burst from his room. "What!" he said. "The atheist guzzles whiskey and eats pork and wallows with his

women all his long life, and then repents the day before he dies and stands guiltless? While I spend a lifetime trying to please G-d?" My grandfather pointed to the book. "So it is written," he said gently. "Written!" the lodger roared. "There are books and there are books." The lodger's outrage seemed highly logical. My grandfather pointed out that cancelling the past does not turn it into a record of achievement. It leaves it blank, a waste of spilled years. A man had better return, he said, while time remains to write a life worth scanning.

Teshuvah is not always easy. Change is hard work! Many things get in the way. But it is important work and it must be done because each of us is authoring a book – the Book of Our Life. Every day, we add sentences, paragraphs and chapters to the book. Now is the time to give some serious thought to the editing process. Teshuvah is a kind of editing. Its results will likely not show up in the chapters already written, but will make themselves readily apparent in those still waiting to be written.

Leshana tova tikateivu – may we all be inscribed into the Book, for health, for life, for happiness and for peace. May the books we write be truly worth reading.

A keen observer of Jewish life, tongue in cheek, once quipped – "How many Jews does it take to change a light bulb?" The answer – "Change?"

This one word "Change," has the knack of planting a sense of fear into the minds of even the most rational of people. Through the years I've come to understand that we often anticipate change with a sense of unease, not because of an understandable fear of the unknown, rather, because we believe we will lose, or be forced to give up something of value, whether real or imagined!

Moving to Baltimore meant, even if for a short time, leaving the familiarity of my "zone of professional comfort" and "rebooting" into a significantly different professional and communal life. I call upon and draw from lessons learnt through years of experience, whilst leveraging and exploring new opportunities for personal and professional growth. I rely on a spirit of teamwork and a supportive infrastructure of dedicated and likeminded professionals working towards shared goals.

In reality, all Jews are effectively mandated to seek self-growth through change – the Torah offers this opportunity during the ten Aseret Y'meiy Teshuvah, the days commencing on Rosh Hashanah and leading to Yom Kippur.

Translated, teshuvah is commonly understood as repentance, and indeed, we are encouraged to "atone" for our wrongful thoughts and actions. However, the core of this word is rooted in the Hebrew, "return", meaning, to restore those core Jewish values which have been diluted over the past year.

Judaism has created the framework of communal gathering and inspirational prayer within which to access this process of spiritual introspection. Viewed in this context then, "Change" is a Jewish value; a divinely mandated opportunity to strive for self- improvement.

Make no mistake. "Change" is complex. It is as much a deeply rooted emotional journey as a process requiring commitment, discipline and a liberal sense of optimism, laced with a generous dose of faith and belief in one's ability to positively embrace the future.

Elaine and I wish you a year of Jewish growth through positive change.

May the coming year 5780 bring us good health, ushering in a period of peace and prosperity for all Israel.

May we all be inscribed in the Book of Life – L'Shanah Tovah Tikateivu v'Teichateimu.


# A Kabbalistic Approach to the **High Holy Days with Cantor Marty**


