

# Rabbinical Reflection: Am Yisrael Chai – Praying for Unity



One of my all-time favorite songs is Am Yisrael Chai the People of Israel Lives. I remember singing it as a young child, probably from the moment it was composed by Shlomo Carlebach in 1965. I still sing it today, and it is still sung by Jews the world over.

No one knows who first introduced the phrase Am Yisrael Chai. There

is a recording of the liberated Jews of Bergen-Belsen concentration camp singing Hatikvah on April 20, 1945. When the anthem ends, there is a brief silence and then a single voice, that of British Army Chaplain Rabbi Leslie Hardman, cries out, "Am Yisroel Chai!" When Golda Meir visited the Great Synagogue in Moscow as the Israeli Ambassador in 1948, the crowd of 50,000 ecstatically welcomed her with shouts of "Am Yisrael Chai." Shlomo Carlebach was asked to compose the now famous melody as a rallying cry for Jews living in the former Soviet Union.

Am Yisrael Chai affirms that despite the many systematic attempts to exterminate and annihilate the Jewish people throughout history, thanks to God's guiding hand and our tenacity and resilience, we have survived and even thrived. After the creation of the State of Israel, this sentiment became even more profound.

It is no secret today, that for many Jews, the State of Israel is not the galvanizing force for Jewish unity that it once was. It is increasingly being seen as divisive and polarizing. There are even Jewish groups whose misguided efforts only serve to drive a wedge between us and Israel. The relationship between U.S. Jews and Israel has become an increasingly tense and difficult one. And this is unfortunate.

Rabbi Efrem Goldberg of the Boca Raton synagogue tells the following story. Upon capturing Yerushalayim more than 50 years ago, Motta Gur uttered the now iconic words, "Har Ha'bayit b'yadeinu...the Temple Mount is in our hands."

Ironically, though, since taking the Old City in 1967, Israeli law has barred Jews from actually praying on Har Ha'bayit, or even from bringing a religious item like a siddur, tehillim, or tefillin there. All this in an effort to prevent provocation of the Arab Muslims on the site of their Dome of the Rock. By Israeli law, Jews can visit, but cannot pray at one of our holiest sites.

In September 2015, Itamar Ben Gvir was touring the holy site when a Muslim woman shouted, "Allahu Akbar" at him. He responded by shouting back, "Am Yisrael Chai." He was immediately arrested by Israeli police who considered the words to be words of prayer, and therefore illegal. Itamar sued for wrongful detention. In 2018, an Israeli court ruled in his favor. It permitted visitors to the Temple Mount to call out, "Am Yisrael Chai" because it is a patriotic slogan, and not

Rabbi Goldberg offered that, while he was happy with the court's ruling, something about its reasoning bothered him. In his opinion, the words Am Yisrael Chai are really more than just a patriotic slogan. The times in which we live, where we often are our own worst enemies and where we have not vet learned to be truly unified and united, demand that we see Am Yisrael Chai as a hopeful prayer for unity.

Rabbi Soloveitchik, commenting on the words from the Torah "V'lakachti etchem li l'am...I will take you to Me as a people," (Shemot 6:7), points out that the Hebrew word AM, nation, is spelled identically to the Hebrew word IM, with. The secret to a strong AM Yisrael is a strong sense of IM Yisrael, of being in it together, united, loyal, and committed to the absolute welfare of the People and the State of Israel.

With Israel's existence and legitimacy being challenged from without and, lamentably, from within, Am Yisrael Chai cannot be a slogan alone, it must also be a prayer.

Am Yisrael Chai! May the people of Israel learn to live with one another in harmony and unity! On the eve of its 72nd birthday, may the State of Israel be blessed with the unwavering support of every Jew, everywhere.

After her grandmother passed away, the Jewish Federation invited her family to the U.S. because her mother's family survived both concentration camps during the Holocaust and Stalinist imprisonment in Siberia. She is so proud of her son, Vladimir, who even during his two tours in Iraq, never removed his Magen David from his neck. He is a medalled U.S. Airforce officer who currently works at an immigration center focusing on anti-terrorism. Her daughter, Olga, lives here in Denver and works as a surgery nurse. She has always known how important her Jewish identity has been in shaping her life- Jews need to be brave and tough. She is happy to have dedicated these many years to teach and inspire young children to love their Jewish identities.

# Colorado Jewish Genealogy Society and BMH-BJ Synagogue Present

Mediterranean Dairy Brunch, Cooking Demo And Discussion With Sephardic Genealogy Expert Sarina Roffé

Sarina Roffé is an expert in Syrian Jewish cooking and author of Backyard Kitchen: Mediterranean Salads (Sephardic Heritage Project, 2016), Backyard Kitchen: The Main Course (Sephardic Heritage Project, 2020), Branching Out from Sepharad (Sephardic Heritage Project, 2017), and the iPhone cooking app Sarina's Sephardic Cuisine. She will be preparing a classic Mediterranean brunch for guests as she discusses the cuisine as the healthiest diet, the Sephardic way of entertaining and Sephardic history from Spain to the diaspora and its genealogy.

Sarina Roffé is a journalist who has published hundreds of articles in journals, newspapers and magazines as well as many recipes. She specializes in Sephardic history, food, culture and genealogy. Sarina's interest in Sephardic cooking began as a child when she watched and assisted her mother, grandmother and aunts in the kitchen. These experiences included cooking for large numbers of people, entertaining, preparing and organizing menus. When she married, Sarina learned her grandmother's art, crafting every dish with care and love. Sarina wanted to pass on the lessons learned

from the women in her family and felt that the foods and their preparation were an important way to convey Sephardic culture to her children.

Sarina's recipes have been included in the New York Times, the New York Times Jewish Cookbook and Joan Nathan's Jewish Cooking in America (Beardsley Award). She also wrote "Food and Drink, Modern Period: Syria." Encyclopedia of Jews in the Islamic World (Brill, Leiden, 2014) and publishes an online blog.

Sarina is founder and president of the Sephardic Heritage Project, Co-Chair of the Brooklyn Jewish Historical Initiative and a board member of the International Association of Jewish Genealogical Societies. She gives presentations often at Jewish genealogy and historical conferences and has completed over a dozen genealogies through her consulting business: Sephardic Genealogical Journeys. Sarina is editor of the award-winning journal Dorot, for the Jewish Genealogical Society of New York. Of Syrian Jewish descent, Sarina holds a BA in journalism, an MA in Jewish history and an MBA.

### Did you know?


The BMH Congregation, founded by Henry Plonsky, was formally incorporated on December 10, 1897 in Denver which at that time was part of Arapahoe County.

In 1898, 10 acres of ground were purchased by the congregation for use as a cemetery in an unincorporated section of Arapahoe County known as Aurora. The charter for Mount Nebo Memorial Park was issued in 1904 and in 1904 Mount Nebo held its first internment.

Mount Nebo is older than its host city of Aurora which was not incorporated until 1929. As a result, Mount Nebo is now a focal point of the Aurora Historical Society. Henry Plonsky is interred at Mount Nebo alongside his wife Adelaide.




# HAFTARAH & TORAH READERS


# **RANDY WEINER**

"Observing the Yahrzeit of a mother, father or other close relation is very important in the Jewish religion. Such observance should include attending at least one service on the day of Yahrzeit to say the Kaddish prayer. In order for Kaddish to be recited, the service must include a minyan of ten men, and those who plan to attend ASSUME, unfairly in my opinion, that a minyan will always be present.

To assure that a minyan will be present, members of the congregation should be willing to commit to attend at least one morning or afternoon service per week, thus helping to make sure that a minyan will be present for those observing Yahrzeit. That is not too much to ask and all congregants should be pleased to participate and help others to more fairly assume the minyan will be present."

"Instead of going home after work and taking a nap or having a drink or fighting with your wife or kids, come to Shul and attend the Minyan. At the Minyan there is ample opportunity to fight with other attendees, criticize, or become-inspired. You will also be doing yourself and others a real favor. We need you."
