### **Rabbinical Reflection**

A couple of years ago, a fascinating gallery opened in Sweden called the Museum of Failure. It exhibits all kinds of business products that failed, such as Google Glass, Heinz Green Ketchup, Crystal Pepsi and the New Coke. The museum features notorious and disastrous failures by otherwise well run and well-known companies. More significantly, though, it is also a testament to how some companies learned to fail well - accepting failure as part of the process of innovation and achievement.

"Failing well" is the name of a leadership course at Smith College in Massachusetts. Students enrolled in the program receive a certificate of failure upon entry, a kind of permission slip to fail. It reads in part: "You are hereby authorized to screw up, bomb or fail at one or more relationships, friendships, exams, extracurriculars or any other choices associated with college... and still be a totally worthy, utterly excellent, human." Many of the students hang it on their dorm room walls, hoping to internalize that failure is not a problem for, or a barrier to learning. It is often a key feature in the process!

Our Torah readings during the next few months come from the book of Vayikra. This third book of the Torah is really all about the missteps and inevitable failures that are part of living life and the process of climbing back and growing from those missteps. The concept of the korban – the offering that affected atonement and brought one closer to God after a sin or spiritual lapse – which is a major part of the book, is part of the Jewish "failing well" curriculum.

Purim involves the threatened Jewish community of Persia, comfortably assimilated after 70 years of exile. Just when all seemed lost, the Jews were saved by God, working behind the scenes. In response, "kimu vekiblu", the Jews reaffirmed their faith and reoriented themselves to make Jewish practice and Jewish living a larger part of their lives.

Pesach, too, offers lessons in failing and growing. Moshe's reluctance to accept the mantle of leadership, his doubts about the Hebrews and his miserable first meeting with Pharaoh were all failures from which he would learn and grow. The newly freed slaves were not only ill prepared to fight against enemies like Amalek, they were hardly ready to receive the Torah. In a matter of weeks, the people were dancing around a Golden Calf. Something was clearly off.

The Torah prescribes a mishkan, the forerunner of the Temple, and the model for every synagogue since. It provided a central address, a location where God's presence could be felt and experienced. It enabled the Israelites to reconnect with God and grow Jewishly.

That is the purpose of every synagogue worthy of the name. It certainly is the purpose of our synagogue, BMH-BJ. We hope you see it that way too.

We will, at a later date, be working with his family to honor this great man.

Our annual event will go forward as planned on March 10, 2019. The event will honor you, our congregants, for without you we have nothing. In speaking with Leland's family, we all

agreed that Leland would want this to be the most successful annual event ever. BMH-BJ was home to Leland, and he worked diligently and selflessly to ensure its importance, relevance and continued growth and survival.

To that end, I ask all of you to join me and the community at our annual event where we will celebrate the growth and ongoing importance of our shul and you our congregants.

We will have music from our Cantor and youth choir, a fantastic menu, silent auction and entertainment from world renowned author and Jewish humorist Michael Krasny.

Michael Krasny is the recipient of numerous awards in broadcasting and journalism. ### Purim Carnival - March 17, 2019



be kind to one another. Thank you." It is important to never forget the revulsions of the holocaust and we appreciate Mrs. Starr sharing her story in Nevertheless We Persisted. The book can be purchased at many book stores including Tattered Cover where Mrs. Starr spoke about the book in late 2018.

Proceeds will go to a foundation for underprivileged girls in NYC that teaches writing skills. The girls come from a variety of backgrounds but in particular include orphans, drug addicts, and survivors of abuse.
