## A View from the East Seaboard

Whenever I attend synagogue services or visit a community for the first time, in the USA or elsewhere. I invariably am offered an opinion as to why, and I quote: "our synagogue / community is unique."

To some extent this is true, because uniqueness may be defined in such broad-ranging and arbitrary terms. Once, upon visiting Marble Arch Synagogue in central London, an aspect of its "uniqueness" was proudly shared with me in terms of the attire expected of officers attending Shabbat and Festival services, namely top-hat and black formal jacket!

I view this quaint peculiarity as "minhag avoteinu" - the custom of our predecessors, for I have seen this elsewhere. Is a synagogue unique since it is "the oldest" in the country? (Tourists to South Africa hear this at the Garden's Shul in Cape Town.)

In Florence, Italy, its magnificent 19th century synagogue, as shared with me, was "uniquely" the most beautiful in Europe! Whilst this might ring true to some, beauty is more often "in the eye of the beholder" and therefore subjective.

Our friends ask Elaine and me repeatedly how we are enjoying Baltimore and Congregation Chizuk Amuno. It dawned upon me, when asked the inevitable "uniqueness" question, that never before had I heard the name "Chizuk Amuno." It is based on an expression of its founders' sentiments years ago that certain "traditional tenets" of their faith were being compromised through changes in their (parent) congregation. Thus, Chizuk Amuno was established in response to unwelcome

change as a "break away" congregation. This is not unique in the annals of Jewish life – in fact the opposite is true. Despite the rationale to its founding, through the years, Chizuk Amuno demonstrated leadership in innovation - and thus is "somewhat unique" within Baltimore.

Today, where many congregations continue to conduct "business as usual," they risk failing to adequately respond to the evolving needs of their congregants, societal change and a host of other factors. They sometimes hide behind a self-defined veneer of "uniqueness" as a defense against, or resistance to, what I term "innovative and imaginative evolution."

History teaches many lessons. Henry Ford clung stubbornly to his Model Tamidst strengthening competition and falling sales, believing blindly in its unassailable "uniqueness." It was the concept and philosophy behind the car, more than the car itself, that made it unique in its

For synagogues and communities to remain relevant, the time is now, given current societal evolution, to re-imagine our "uniqueness" and vigorously seek and implement solutions to our challenges without compromising our core

May the coming summer season offer us all the blessing of renewed energy and insight, and the courage to continue shaping our Jewish





## Summer Movies with BMH-BJ

Movies are one of the highlights of the season and BMH-BJ will be offering several opportunities to catch a movie with our community throughout the summer of 2019.

Children of the Inquisition, a new documentary feature-film premiering in Denver June 5 will reveal the ancient, deeply connected roots that Jewish, Latino, Caribbean and Middle Eastern people have shared, sometimes unknowingly, other times secretly, for over 500 years. The expulsion of Iberian Jews from Spain and Portugal in the 15th through 17th centuries is one of the most underestimated events in human history. A rich culture that flourished in Sepharad for nearly a thousand years was forced to flee to lands unknown. As thousands traveled to the New World and beyond, with them went their customs and particular expression of Judaism—the Sephardim. Persecuted for their faith by the Spanish Inquisition, many converted or went underground, only to survive in secret.

Lovett Stories and Strategies, an award-winning film company in NYC, New York, has spent the last ten years exploring this meaningful subject, from the initial two years of research, through six years of shooting and two-plus years of post-production. Via Inquisition records and historical accounts, plus animated maps,

> Joseph Lovett is an award-winning filmmaker, who after working at ABC News 20/20 as director/ producer, founded Lovett Productions in 1989. In 2001, he won a Peabody Award and received an Emmy nomination for writing, producing and directing HBO's Cancer: Evolution to Revolution. His latest film, "Going Blind," and its outreach campaign, has ignited awareness to improve access to vision enhancement services. He has been honored with numerous awards from advocacy organizations, such as the AIDS Leadership Award, the Christopher Award and the Kitty Carlisle Hart Award.

## Midrasha - Confirmation



Midrasha-Confirmation students Halley Mackiernan (daughter of Bill & Melissa) and Samantha Shoflick (daughter of Steven & Megan) recently studied selections from the Passover Haggadah in depth with Rabbi Chaitovsky. They analyzed the famous "Four Children", reviewing various traditional and contemporary approaches to understand who these "four" might be. After choosing a comment that appealed to them, each student created a torn paper art piece that illustrated their chosen commentary.

Shown above are Halley and Sam holding their "Art of Interpretation" creations.

#### Words from Sam Shoflick:

"My piece of art represents the idea that the four children and their personalities progressively appear in one's life. One begins their life completely reliant and unable to ask questions represented through the smaller orange strip on the art. An individual then grows up and begins to question the world, seen through the larger blue strip right below. Now this blue strip is not alone for when the child is progressing, they do not lose their previous identity. Next, challenge and resilience become the permanent factor in one's journey. This part of one's life is represented by the growing green strip which still includes two smaller strips of green and blue as the previous qualities remain. Finally, represented by the red strip, one enters the end of their path, where they have grown the brain to be an independent individual. Furthermore, all the previous qualities of the fourth children linger within this grown up personality."

#### Words from Halley Mackiernan:

"During the holiday of Passover, one is supposed to talk about the four children and how they are represented in our lives today. The four children consist of the wise one, the simple one, the wicked one and the one who is unable to ask questions. During a person's lifetime, aspects of these four children are exemplified through one's actions. I had to represent this idea only utilizing torn paper. I created this image by creating one human out of torn white paper and then inside of the person is the four different children; red being the wicked child, green being the simple child, orange representing the child unable to ask questions and the blue child demonstrating the wise child. Also, throughout each of these children are parts of the other children. By including all of the different children in one person, I established the idea that the four children live in all of us."

#### A Good Salad

Eating a cool salad is beneficial for the heart, brain, weight, and soul. Here are some options for a good salad - buy organic, local, and from the farmers markets. The recipe is from the late Chef Morris L. Starr, son of Fanny Starr. Kashrut laws do apply.

Make the salad dressing in advance and chill in refrigerator.

#### Peach Vinaigrette Salad Dressing Ingredients

(gauge your measurements for your taste)

- -1 large ripened peach sliced, and remove the pit (gauge to your taste)
- -2 tablespoons olive oil
- -1 tablespoon of a champagne vinaigrette or red wine vinegar
- -1-2 tablespoons of honey (gauge your own sweet level)
- -Zest of a lime (gauge your taste because the oils are strong, but add flavor)
- -Add kosher salt and ground pepper to taste
- -2 teaspoons of black sesames seeds or poppy seeds
- -Extras if you like it spicy add-in peppers for savory add-in herbs

In a blender or processor add-in the ingredients; set the settings to puree.

#### In a Bowl Add Lettuce

-Your choice (iceberg, romaine, butter, etc.)

**Salad Add-Ins:** (be creative as to what you add-in)

- -Grilled Beets and use the leaves (swiss chard)
- -Berries of your choice (blackberries, raspberries, strawberries)
- -Corn of your choice (grilled on the cob, or frozen and roasted in the oven)
- -Fruits (watermelon, peaches, etc.)
- -Herbs (mint, cilantro, dill)
- -Peppers (hot, mild, red, orange, yellow)

- -Radishes
- -Tomatoes

Your Choice of Cheeses: (it can be made non-dairy)

Your Choice of Nuts: (use as a condiment on the table for those with allergies)
