Rabbinical Reflection

Got Light?

Sounds like the perfect question for the Festival of Lights, better known as Chanukah, that starts on the 25th of Kislev, this year the evening of December 2nd.

The tradition of lighting the Chanukah lights is an ancient one. But why do we light these lights? It depends on who you ask, apparently.

Cultural anthropologists say Chanukah was little more than a Jewish version of the common light festival, bringing much needed light and cheer during the often depressing darkness of the winter season. Sounds a little dismissive, to me. Historians offer that it was to celebrate an astonishing, against all odds, military victory of Jews fighting for religious freedom against their Syrian Greek oppressors. The Rabbis saw it as a commemoration of the miracle of the little cruse of oil that somehow lasted eight days longer than it should have and allowed the victorious Jews to re-enter their holy Temple and resume the daily practice of kindling the lights of the menorah found inside.

This Rabbinic reason is different than the other explanations. It is spiritual. It highlights a sense of mission on the part of the Jews. And it allows for justifiable Jewish pride in achieving a victory over oppressors who would have them forget their Jewish practices and turn their backs on their own distinctive history.

And this perhaps explains why it remains the most popular and durable "reason" for lighting Chanukah lights. This message of Chanukah is much needed today.

Why do the organizations seeking to boycott, divest and sanction Israel count disproportional numbers of Jews as members? Why are some of the most virulent and ferocious attacks against Israel led by Jews? Why, according to a recent Pew study, do nearly half of American Jews prefer not to identify with organized

There is no simple answer to these profoundly vexing questions. Individually and collectively, Jews would benefit from a greater awareness of Jewish history and greater sensitivity to our distinctive Jewish mission. Most significantly, Jews would benefit from a good dose of Jewish pride – pride in our heritage, pride in Israel and pride in the Jewish people.

So get some light. Share the light. Don't just be a Jew. be a proud Jew!






YONI BUCKMAN


Bar Mitzvah: Levi Samuel Engbar



"Srugim", the Hebrew word for knitted kipot, is an Israeli television show set in modern day Jerusalem. It follows the lives of a group of young modern Orthodox singles maneuvering their way through the challenging and complicated world of dating, finding fulfilling careers, maintaining friendships, and just plain everyday life. The thread that weaves throughout is how to do this with modern technology, cell phones, texting, etc. and still adhere to your religious beliefs, customs and practices.

You will love the characters, they are friendly, good looking, and nice to each other, most of the time. They are relatable and seem to face the same challenges as we all do in our everyday lives. In one of the early episodes, a handsome young doctor is on a date with a nice young girl. It's late, he decides to stay over, on the couch, of course, and in the morning he needs to borrow someone's tefillin. He doesn't have his own with him, he didn't plan on staying over, after all. The problem is, the only ones that can be found in the neighbouring apartments, belong to a girl, well, that is a dilemma, what is there to do?

There are many reasons that this TV show will draw you in. It touches on the laws of kashrut, there are regular Shabbat dinners, many scenes of everyday life in Jerusalem, and attention to

detail paid to religious traditions and custom. The background music is nice too, especially the opening theme song. But most of all the characters will keep you watching. They are well rounded and fully developed, you really get to know them and the difficult decisions they have to make in order to maintain their Judaism and live in a modern world. Their interactions with each other are real and as you get to know them you will empathize with them and learn to love them. Wow, that's pretty heavy for a regular TV show!

The show is interesting, funny, thoughtful, and just plain good entertainment for a snowy evening or Sunday afternoon. I've waited until now to let you know that it does have subtitles.
