Rabbinical Corner

As I write this, the war in Israel continues unabated. Perhaps when you read this, things will be different. Let us hope and pray that will be the case.

Take a look at the calendar for the next few months: Purim. Pesach. The Omer. Yom HaShoa. Yom haZikaron. Yom haAtzmaut. Lag baOmer. Yom Yerushalyim. Shavuot. At no other time of the year does our calendar more accurately reflect the realities of Jewish history - the ups and downs, the anxieties, the perils and persecutions,

and, of course, our salvations and survival. Against all odds, with the help of God and our own courageous determination, we survived the antisemitic genocidal whims of Pharaohs, Ceasars, Hamans, Hitlers and their ilk throughout history.

The "downs" of history, sadly, continue to this very day. The horrific crimes against humanity perpetrated by Hamas on October 7th, like the attack of Amalek against the newly freed Israelites about which we will read on Shabbat Zachor, have paved the way and emboldened haters around the globe to magnify and multiply their assaults, in words and deeds, against Jews everywhere. The UN, UNRWA and the nation of South Africa have again and again revealed their true colors as they deign to saddle the Jewish State, which was forced to defend itself, with the charge of genocide and disproportionate aggression. The many uninformed calls for cease fire – with no call for the release of hostages taken by Hamas and their allies – fail to recognize that there was a cease fire in place until October 7, 2023.

Even here in the United States, Jews remain increasingly targeted by hate agitators. On college campuses, at malls, in city councils (take a bow, Chicago) and on the streets of our cities, rampant dis-information and propaganda continue to incite individuals to spread more hatred and carry out assaults against Jews. Sadly, inexplicably, we do not feel safe.

The Jewish calendar reminds us of the buffeting winds and stormy seas of our collective history. Unfortunately, those winds and storms have not subsided. Our calendar urges us to be diligent and resilient. As we have survived and thrived in the past, so will we in the future. Am Yisrael Chai! Ken yehi ratzon...Amen!



If you need help, please call the office, so we can help you sell your chametz over the phone. Deadline for submission is Tuesday, April 16, 2024. You can use the form on the inside back cover if you choose not to use our online form.

Maot Chitim

We are collecting donations for "Wheat Money." This is an ancient religious obligation. Its traditional form was a response to the insufficiency of kosher product used for baking Matzah. Poor families had to rationalize the amount of Matzah eaten or to survive without it altogether. Raising money for less privileged families thus became an obligation, which has stood the test of time. You can make this donation at the time of your sale of chametz.

The Daffodil Project- Part II

Last Autumn, our BMH-BJ community came together to participate in a significant global initiative. We planted daffodil bulbs in our newly established garden near the north entrance off Monaco, joining a worldwide effort to create a *Living Holocaust Memorial*. This meaningful act, while seemingly small, holds profound significance as it contributes to the collective goal of planting 1.5

million daffodils. Each daffodil represents a child lost during the Holocaust, serving as a moving reminder of the atrocities endured during that dark period of history.

Moreover, our participation in this initiative extends beyond remembrance. It symbolizes our solidarity with children facing crises in our world today, such as those impacted by the horrific October 7, 2023 Hamas attacks.

By planting these daffodils, we stand in support of hope, resilience, and the enduring spirit of life.

With our involvement, over 660,000 daffodils have been planted at 266 locations worldwide. The yellow daffodil, reminiscent of the yellow star Jews were forced to



wear during the Holocaust, serves as a powerful symbol of remembrance and resilience. Its vibrant return each spring echoes the strength of the human spirit and serves as a beacon of hope for the future.

As we eagerly await the emergence of these daffodils from their winter slumber, we are filled with anticipation and hope. Together, let us honor this meaningful symbol and continue to stand against hatred and injustice in all its forms.

Because the sale of chametz involves many technicalities, it is customary for the clergy of the congregation to act as the agent for all who wish to sell their chametz. If you own chametz in several places – your regular home, summer home and business, for example – fill in all addresses. Everyone who prepares a home for Pesach should arrange with the clergy to sell their chametz. By signing this convenient Statement of Authorization our clergy uses this power of attorney to sell your chametz. Use the form below to authorize the sale of your chametz. Delegation of Power of Attorney - Passover 2024/5784

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Chaitovsky to act in my place and stead and in my behalf to sell all chametz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by The Torah and Rabbinic Law and to lease all places wherein the chametz owned by me may be found, especially in the premises located at the address(es) below.

Rabbi Chaitovsky has the full right to sell and to lease by transactions, as he deems fit and proper and for such time which he believes necessary in accordance with all detailed terms and detailed forms as explained in the general authorization contracts which have been give this year to Rabbi Chaitovsky to sell the chametz. This general authorization is made a part of this agreement. Also, I hereby give Rabbi Chaitovsky full power and authority to appoint a substitute in his stead with full power to sell and to lease as provided herein. The above given power is in conformity with all Torah, Rabbinical regulations and laws and also in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado and of the United States.
