Parasha Summary

The *Sidrah* tells of the experiences of the Israelites about four centuries after they had come down to Egypt from Canaan. A new Pharaoh comes to power, "who knew not Joseph," and begins to break the spirit of the Hebrews. In the midst of severe persecution, Moses is born and his mother, eager to save him places him in a basket set afloat on the river. The daughter of Pharaoh discovers the baby and saves him from drowning. Although Moses is raised as a prince in Pharaoh's palace, he develops great pity for the Hebrew slaves in their unhappy condition and suffering. One day he accidentally kills an Egyptian in defense of a Hebrew slave causing him to flee to the north where he lives as a shepherd for many years. He is one day instructed by a voice from a burning bush to return to Egypt and liberate the Israelite slaves.
