Parashat Lech Lecha Summary G-d speaks to Abram, commanding him, "Go from your

land, from your birthplace and from your father's house, to the land which I will show you." There, G-d says, he will be made into a great nation. He must leave behind everything he has known in order to begin a relationship with G-d which is to develop for him into a deep faith. Once he arrives in Canaan G-d promises him that this land will become the home of his descendants. Abram's name is changed to Abraham as part of a new covenant with G-d, through circumcision. Later on, Sarai, his wife, becomes Sarah. The males in his household are circumcised, forever after the sign of the Covenant between Abraham's descendants and G-d.
