

The *Sidrah* begins with the arrival of three strangers at Abraham’s tent with messages from G-d. He is told that a son will be born to his wife Sarah and that soon Sodom and Gomorrah will be destroyed as punishment for its people’s evil ways. Abraham pleads with G-d not to destroy the people and G-d assures him that if ten worthwhile people can be found in the cities that they will not be destroyed. However, no worthwhile people are found and only Abraham’s nephew, Lot, and his family escape the destruction. Isaac is born and as he grows up Sarah requests that Abraham send Hagar and Ishmael away in order to protect Isaac from bad influence. Abraham faces the ultimate challenge when G-d asks him to sacrifice Isaac. As he is about to carry out G-d’s will G-d informs him that it was only a test, He does not desire human sacrifice.




