The Sidrah tells of procedures to be carried out with the Mishkan, Israel's house of worship in he wilderness during their wanderings towards the Promised Land. This includes the continual burning of the Menorah in font of the Holy of Holies, and the garments warn by the Kohanim and the High Priest during services.

The additional Torah reading for *Shabbat Zachor* is Deuteronomy 25:17-19. Israel is to remember the treacherous attack of Amalek when they were in the desert. Because Amalek struck the first unprompted blow against the seemingly defenseless children of Israel during their Exodus march from Egypt the Amalekites should never be forgiven.

Haftarat Zachor Summary

The Shabbat before Purim is designated as Shabbat Zachor. An extra portion of the Torah is read, in addition to the *Sidrah*. It tells of the brutal attack against Israel by Amalek, during their years in the wilderness. In turn, Israel is commanded to remember that treachery of Amalek.

The *Haftarah* of Shabbat Zachor deals also with Amalek's aggression against Israel, later, during the reign of King Saul. The Prophet Samuel instructs Saul to retaliate for Amalek's treachery. According to tradition, Haman, who wished to destroy the Jews of Persia, was a descendant of Amalek. Hence, the special readings on the Shabbat before Purim.
