Haftarah Summary

In the *Haftarah*, Isaiah urges the King, Ahaz of Judea, to keep his faith in G-d so that he would not, then, need to be afraid of the enemy. Later, Isaiah makes known that the son of King Ahaz will be a good ruler of his people and that during his reign as King of Judea there will be peace and justice in the land.

The link between the *Haftarah* and the *Sidrah* is the revelation experience of Moses and Israel at *Har Sinai* and that of Isaiah many centuries later. The two messengers were summoned by G-d to speak to the people.

Non-stop flights of 35 Israeli aircraft, including Israeli Air Force C-130s and El Al Boeing 747s, transported 14,325 Ethiopian Jews to Israel in 36 hours.

Jerry Kopelman will also tell the larger story of "Operation Moses", organized in 1984 to clandestinely bring as many Ethiopian Jews as possible to Israel. The immigrants, who were forbidden to depart Ethiopia, faced numerous dangers along the way.
