Parshah Summary

Last week's *Parshah* described the signs of the *metzora* (commonly mistranslated as "leper") — a person afflicted by a spiritual malady which places him or her in a state of ritual impurity. This week's *Sidrah* begins by detailing how the recovered *metzora* is purified by the *Kohen* (priest) with a special procedure involving two birds, spring water in an earthen vessel, a piece of cedar wood, a scarlet thread and a bundle of hyssop.

A home can also be afflicted with *tzaraat* by the appearance of dark red or green patches on its walls. In a process lasting as long as nineteen days, a *Kohen* determines if the house can be purified or whether it must be demolished.

Ritual impurity is also engendered through a seminal or other discharge in a man, and menstruation or other discharge of blood in a woman, necessitating purification through immersion in a mikvah.

In Today's Haftarah

The *Haftarah*, Malachi 3:4-24, describes the last of the Prophets. Malachi delivers his message about 450 B.C.E. The Second Temple has been rebuilt by now, but Malachi is not completely happy about his people's religious faith. It must be strengthened and their loyalty to G-d's teachings must be complete.

When the people will have reached the stage of true religiosity, there will follow a full redemption of Israel and mankind. Elijah will come as an advance messenger and announce the beginning of the Messianic era.

This reading from Malachi on the Shabbat immediately before Pesach/Passover sets the mood for the Holiday of Redemption.
