Parshah Vaetchanan (Vaetchanan — Devarim/Deuteronomy 3:23-7:11 pg 958)

The *Sidrah* is a continuation of the first of Moses' three farewell talks to Israel before his death. In the first talk Moses reviews for the people teachings learned at *Har Sinai* (Mount Sinai) and appeals to them not to forget what they experienced there. G-d has chosen Israel from among the nations to live by Torah law. They must have nothing to do with idol worship and pagan ways nor intermarry with pagan peoples. Israel is to have faith in the One G-d and be loyal.

In his second farewell talk to Israel he reviews the Ten Commandments and various laws, and repeats the *Shema*. Israel must "love" G-d, study His teachings carefully, and live by them in and outside their homes. Moses warns Israel as strongly as possible that, when they enter Canaan, they must live their own sacred way of life. They must not intermarry with any of the pagan people whom they will meet in Canaan. To do so would weaken Israel's Covenant with G-d.

In Today's Haftarah (Isaiah 40:1-26; pg 1196)

In the *Haftarah*, from the Book of Isaiah, the Judeans have been living in Babylonian exile, far from Jerusalem, for nearly a half-century. Isaiah continues the work of the previous *Nevi'im* (Prophets) and assures the new generation of exiles that G-d has forgiven them for the wrongs committed in the past. "*Nachamu, Nachamu Ami, Yomar Elokeichem*" - "Comfort thee, comfort thee, my people, says your G-d." The penalty for wrongdoing has been paid and G-d in all his power will make possible the people's return to Zion. "Speak to the heart Jerusalem and proclaim unto her; Done is the term of punishment; Gone is the guilt that was hers."




Friday Night Shabbat Dinner—Friday, September 6, 2019 at 7:30 pm
