3. Instructions for using ZOOM are below. It really is fairly simple, whether you choose to download the app or just dial in.

ZOOM Instructions for Participants Before a videoconference:

1. You will need a computer, tablet, or smartphone with speaker or headphones. You will have the opportunity to check your audio immediately upon joining a meeting.

2. You will receive notice by email for a videoconference or conference call and the notification will include a link to “Join via computer” as well as phone numbers for a conference call option. It will also include the 9-digit (usually) Meeting ID.

To join the ZOOM videoconference:

1. At the start time of your meeting, click on the link in your invitation to join via computer. You may be instructed to download the Zoom application.

2. You have an opportunity to test your audio at this point by clicking on "Test Computer Audio." Once you are satisfied that your audio works, click on "Join audio by computer."
3. You may also join a meeting without clicking on the invitation link by going to [join.zoom.us](https://join.zoom.us) on any browser and entering the Meeting ID provided.

**If you are having trouble hearing the meeting, you can join via telephone while remaining on the video conference:**

1. On your phone, dial the teleconferencing phone number provided in your invitation.
2. Enter the Meeting ID number (also provided in your invitation) when prompted using your touch-tone keypad.
3. You can also join a conference without being on screen by simply dialing the number and then enter the meeting ID.
