

Now Hiring: Online Hebrew Tutor



The Alvin Browdy Religious School at Ohr Kodesh Congregation is hiring online Hebrew tutors for our 3rd-7th grade supplemental school. Hebrew tutors should be proficient in “*tefillah* Hebrew,” able to guide students through fluent reading and chanting of specific prayers, with knowledge of key prayer vocabulary and ability to describe the meaning and context of parts of liturgy. Prayer recordings and preferred tunes will be made available as requested.

Tutors meet 1-on-1 or 1-on-2 with students for half-hour sessions, on a weekly basis at a time that is convenient to the tutor and the student.

Tutors will

- Independently plan engaging and challenging activities and reviews for students, with curricular guidance from director.
- Proficiently navigate Zoom or another online platform of their choice to meet with students or to pull up share-screen resources.
- Communicate questions or issues to the school director in a timely manner.
- Communicate with families about session dates and times, rescheduling.
- Report tutoring session promptly to ensure appropriate feedback and payroll.

Our standard tutoring rate is \$55/hour. All tutors are employees of the synagogue and must submit standard financial paperwork

Ohr Kodesh is a Conservative synagogue that engages with the full traditional liturgy of Jewish worship.
