Dear friends.

One of the events my family looks forward to in the summer is attending baseball games. Most often we catch a Chicago Cub game at Wrigley field and a Red Sox game against the Yankees. We are expanding our reach and this summer we will go to a Mets game as well. The official anthem to North American baseball is, of course, the song "Take Me Out to the Ballgame." But did you know that the music was written by a Jewish mid-Westerner?

Albert Gumbinsky was born in Indianapolis. His older brother, Harry took his mother's maiden name Tilzer, and to be even classier, added the German nobility title, calling himself Harry Von Tilzer. The other three brothers soon followed Harry's lead, and changed their names to Von Tilzer. Harry became a publisher of sheet music. Albert Von Tilzer was a top song-writer, creating hundreds of melodies for many tin-pan alley lyricists, including the music for "Take Me Out to the Ballgame."

It is not surprising that a Jew would be involved in creating the national anthem for the quintessential American pastime. Jews created much of the American Songbook. What is surprising is that Von Tilzer wrote the song without having ever attended a baseball game! He attended his first baseball game 20 years after writing the song.

As we anticipate heading back to the beach or to the movies, or sharing a barbeque with dear ones, let's take a moment to thank our incredibly talented Jewish brothers and sisters, who provide the songs and melodies that help create American culture.

CELEBRATING ISRAEL AT 75 IN SONG

To continue Israel's 75th Birthday celebration, the Jewish Choir of Central NJ, Makhelat Hamercaz, will be presenting a gala concert at Neve Shalom. It will take place in our sanctuary on Wednesday, June 7 at

7:30 pm. The program features the thirty voiced choir directed by Cantor Anna West Ott and me. Our accompanist is the amazing Dave Schlossberg and we will feature three outstanding singers as soloists: Cantors Ott and Mark Stanton of Anshe Emeth, and Benjamin T. Berman.

The varied repertoire will connect us with Israel and the pieces are either by Israeli composers or have texts about Israel. These will include classical, pop, reggae, or liturgical, and covers many centuries and countries. Selections will include songs you know such as "Oseh Shalom" by **Nurit Hirsch** and "Havah Nagila," but with interesting arrangements which raises the level of these songs. A moving prayer for Israel by **Cantor Meir Finkelstein** and a new setting of the text of "Hatikvah" are uplifting. Beautiful songs by **Naomi Shemer, Gil Aldema**, and other Israeli composers will be

featured. A new setting of the Kaddish prayer by **Danny Maseng** will be performed. **Matisyahu's** "One Day," and some joyful selections such as "Hallelujah" from the Eurovision contest of 1979 will be sung.

The choir has been invited to perform at this year's North American Jewish Choral festival and this is an opportunity to hear them here in our synagogue.

You can purchase tickets in Neve Shalom's office, from Hazzan Levin, or by mail at P.O. Box 1256, Highland Park, NJ 08904

Seniors are \$15 per person, General Admission is \$20 per seat. Friends (\$36), Patrons (\$50 per person), Benefactors (\$180 for 4), and Angels (\$360 for 4) options are also available. There will be a delicious dessert reception following the program and we will be honoring the choir's president, **Roz Shaw**, who will soon be leaving the community. Jewish Federation in the Heart of NJ, Middlesex County Council of the Arts, and Discover NJ, are sponsors of this program. This is the 20th year of Mercaz bringing Jewish music to Central NJ and beyond and we invite you to be with us in person (or on Zoom) for this very special event.

From the President

It has been my honor to serve as President of Neve Shalom. In my 17 months as your President, I have supported the launch of The Metuchen Preschool at Neve Shalom, been persistent in encouraging concrete proposals for the disposition of our building and property and partnered with **Rabbi Schoenberg**. I hope that we have made Neve Shalom a better place than when we started, both for the community, and a permanent rabbi.

I know this is a challenging time for the community, through the resignation of my predecessor, an interim rabbi, the ongoing search for a permanent rabbi, and the conversations about our building and property. Let's not forget that I gave my High Holiday address from a knee scooter, after fracturing my foot in a freak accident!

Statistics are showing that religious institutions in general are demographically challenged, and we are no exception, the "nones", those who say their religion is "nothing in particular," are the fastest growing religious affiliation. The good news is that the leadership of Neve Shalom have been responsible stewards of our budgets, and we have ample cash reserves. This cannot be an excuse for ignoring our demographic and institutional realities, however it does give us breathing room to explore what sustainability looks like for Neve Shalom.

As I turn over leadership to my friend **Stuart Shlossman**, I know the institution will be in good hands. Stuart cares deeply about the synagogue and our spiritual mission. He will lead a collaborative and thoughtful effort to envision the future of Neve Shalom.

What would a message from me be, without a reference to a contemporary Jewish song. The words of "Ayzehu Chacham" by **Josh Nelson**, (based on Pirkei Avot 4.1), have been in my head as I write this column (snap the QR code to hear the song):

Do you hear, or do you listen? Do you look, or do you see? Can you feel a separation? Because of you? Because of me? There are truths in one another, There are troubles we have seen. There is hope in understanding, There is life in the space between. By Harold S. Geller

(Who is wise? Those who learn from all people.)

May we all have the wisdom to listen to each other, and see what the realities of our community are, without looking back at the past ways of doing things, and be the welcoming and vital community that I know we can be!

I want to thank **Rita Devlin** for her constant support, Rabbi Schoenberg for his partnership, and leadership, and finally **Robbie, Melanie** and **David** for their patience with me as I did my best to balance synagogue, home and professional duties.

A nother wonderful and productive school year has come to a close. The memories, however, will last a lifetime.

Our Mother's Day Tea was lovely! We began with a special song the children sang to their mothers, as well as presenting them with a gift. All the moms (and a dad) began their special day by decorating

challah covers with their *yeladim*/children. We heard from our *Kita Yud*/10th graders, who recently made a *siyum*/confirmation, where they revisited their feelings

about what being Jewish means to them. It was a reminder that just a couple of years ago, they accepted upon themselves the responsibilities of becoming a bar mitzvah.

We also recognized five *talmidiml* students ranging in age from six years old through ten years old, who came consistently to shul services. They each received a gift certificate for a free slice of pizza to Jerusalem Pizza in Highland Park!


