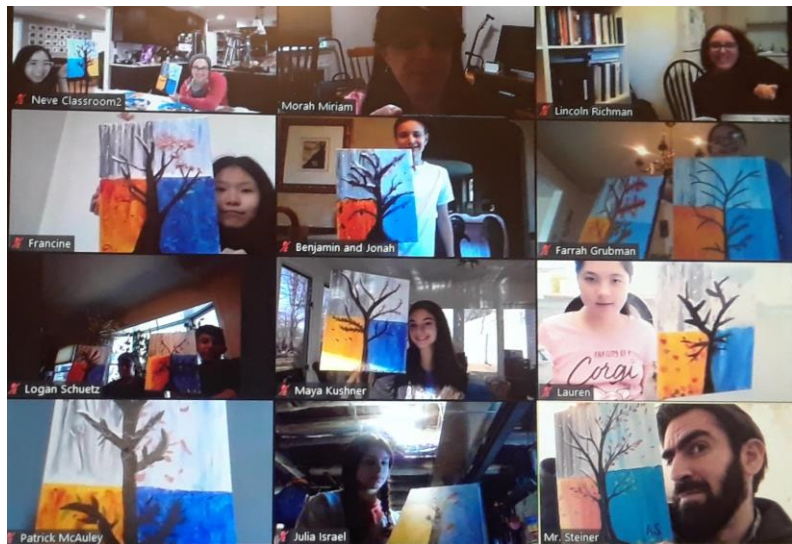

Curriculum and Philosophy

Our Religious School offers a variety of subjects in its curricula to whet the appetite and interests of its students. As young as the *Gan*, kindergarten, we begin with basic *tefillot*/prayers adding concepts such as *Shabbat*/Sabbath, *Chagim*/holidays, and vocabulary such as colors in Hebrew. By the time the *yeladim*/children become *talmidim*/students entering 7th grade, they will be able to read with some fluency a *siddur*/prayerbook and write in Hebrew print. They will also be in the midst of preparing to accept the responsibilities of a *Bar/Bat Mitzvah*, coming of age to accept and fulfill the commandments from the *Torah*, Bible.

Every child is an individual and as such, materials will be presented in a variety of ways. Each teacher has a different means of communicating these concepts to the class. In our world of technology, music, media, videos, art, combined with text and discussion will present a well-rounded methodology of educating these young minds. These are our long term goals. The most effective and productive way to achieve these goals is with the cooperation and participation of the families.
