In previous years, the K-2 tuition had been fully underwritten through the generosity of several donors with the goal of growing the program and introducing Neve Shalom to new families. Going forward, these donors have decided to direct their philanthropy towards other aspects of our community. Still, **the per day cost of our school at \$19** is significantly lower than many other extracurricular activities thanks to the financial support the school continues to receive from the synagogue.

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8. You can save by paying your dues with appreciated stock!

Donating appreciated stock can help maximize your tax savings while supporting a great cause. Donations of appreciated stock are fully deductible at their full market value *and* avoid capital gains taxes that you would have to pay when selling the stock.

	Scenario: Family earning \$100,000 annually		
	Sell securities and donate cash	Donate appreciated securities	
Strategy	Sell securities worth \$2600 in cash and donate \$2600 cash.	Donate appreciated securities worth \$2600 and an unrealized gain of \$1734 .

For an earner in the top tax bracket, the savings from this same scenario would be \$1375.

Even if you don't need to sell securities to generate cash today, donating appreciated stock and using on-hand to buy that same stock saves you money later by creating a free step-up in basis.

Ready to donate appreciated stock?

- The most straightforward option is to directly transfer stocks by contacting your broker and giving them instructions about which shares you wish to transfer to Neve Shalom. The synagogue office can supply you with our account information. Please let the office know to expect the transfer, as our broker will not notify us.
- A second option is to give through a donor advised fund a giving vehicle that allows donors to make a charitable
 contribution, take an immediate tax deduction, and decide later which organizations to disburse the funds to.

Donor advised funds are not just for the wealthy – many have minimum contributions of \$5,000 (less than two years of dues). They can greatly streamline the process of donating appreciated stock, especially if you choose a fund affiliated with your brokerage firm; most have online tools that help you identify the most tax-efficient stocks to donate.

Donor advised funds have different fees, minimums, and restrictions on the types of organizations you can support. If you know you want to pay your dues through a donor advised fund, we recommend reaching out first to confirm that they will permit grant recommendations to Neve Shalom.

9. Over 70½? You can save taxes by paying dues from your tax-deferred accounts.

Each year the IRS requires you to take your RMD (required minimum distribution) from your tax deferred retirement accounts. This distribution is 100% taxable, but you can reduce your taxes by paying your dues as a Qualified Charitable Distribution from your IRA.

For example, if you make a donation of \$2,400 to Neve Shalom, you will pay no taxes on the \$2,400. The key is that the \$2,400 is counted as part of your RMD and is not taxable. Important: in order to realize this benefit, the distribution must go directly from the custodian to the charity; if the money goes first to you or any other intermediary, the distribution will be taxable.
