YIOZ Expansion Update

The Building Expansion Committee made further progress this week in our discussions with contractors and in other matters.

In the days and weeks ahead we hope to finalize discussions with contractors, have our architect draw the next set of more detailed drawings, explore lines of credit/mortgage, and apply for homeland security funds available to shuls.

We will share the more detailed drawings with the general membership when we receive them. We will then call a meeting of the general membership to discuss the project and to approve the financial outlay.

As of today, we have redeemed pledges and commitments of approximately 1.25 million dollars. We have another 500k available from the shul's reserves. We aim to have as small a mortgage as possible, so we must raise a significant amount of additional funds from our membership beginning this summer.

Thank you for your support in arriving at this juncture. We look forward to working together on this exciting project!
