Message from Rabbi Shmuel Hain

This is a wonderful evening of celebration for our thriving, growing, warm, and unique community. This dinner and journal have been a remarkable success by all conventional metrics for shul dinners: attendance, funds raised, and excitement generated. But I think there is more to this shul dinner, and to this gathering.



My role tonight is to conclude the program. Let's turn our attention to the conclusion of *Sefer Breishit*, the very last scene in the book which we will read this upcoming Shabbat. It is a type-scene, one of a number of that genre in *Sefer Breishit*. Like the various encounters between husbands and wives at a drawing well in Genesis, the deathbed scene is a *Breishit* type-scene. The beauty of this literary convention is that it takes a common scene we are all familiar with and challenges readers to identify the differences from the established type thereby highlighting significant developments in plot and character.

In *Breishit*, before someone passes away, they often present blessings. Yitzchak does it, Yaakov does it, and, in the final scene of *Sefer Breishit*, Yosef does it:

23 Joseph lived to see children of the third generation of Ephraim; the children of Machir son of Manasseh were even born upon Joseph's knees. **24** Joseph said to his brothers, "I am about to die. God will surely take notice of you and bring you up from this land to the land that He promised on oath to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob." **25** So Joseph made the sons of Israel swear, saying, "When God has taken notice of you, you shall carry up my bones from here." **26** Joseph died at the age of one hundred and ten years; and he was embalmed and placed in a coffin in Egypt.

What is different about this scene, the scene of Yosef dying and giving a last will and testament, some final blessings? You could easily miss it because the Torah says Yosef lived a long and nachas-filled life, with great, great grandchildren sitting upon his knees. What is unique is the audience around

his bed. Yosef's final recorded words are to his siblings, not his children. And the message he delivers to his brothers is most significant. He makes a promise to them: You, too, will be redeemed by God. You, my brothers, are all recipients of the *Birkat Avraham*. We are all going back to the Promised Land!

And when you notice this anomaly, you realize that Yaakov had not made this promise to his other children on his deathbed. He had given each of them blessings, but all children in *Breishit* receive blessings. But only Yosef and his children had previously been told by Yaakov that they would inherit the land of their forefathers. Only Yosef's family had received the *Birkat Avraham*.

And do not mistake Yosef's blessing for prophecy. Yosef did not have more prophetic access than Yaakov. Rather than prophecy, Yosef possessed a certain kind of hard-earned emotional wisdom, a generosity of spirit, and a faith in the united future of the Jewish people. These are the elements which enabled Yosef to share his particular family's blessing with the rest of the brothers. Yosef on his deathbed made sure that his brothers were there, and at that moment he enshrined that all of Yaakov's children would be a part of *Bnei Yisrael* in *Eretz Yisrael*. Yosef's vision of inclusivity is the final scene of *Breishit*. And it is that scene which transforms a family with a history of conflict into a unified *Am Yisrael*.

Our honorees and dinner chairs all possess that same vision of inclusivity, as well as the determination and will to make that vision a reality. Look around—this shul dinner is a different scene than the typical shul dinner. This is a shul dinner where all members feel included and participate! Thanks to our lay leadership, our honorees, our dinner committee, and all of you, our dinner tonight is a true success, and a reflection of Yosef's dream of what a Jewish community and nation can look like.


