Masada College Torah Stream Seeks Jewish Studies Teacher

The educator will serve as a main Kodesh teacher for our Torah Stream track focused on primary aged students (boys and girls) from Year K through Year 6. Our educators are instrumental in bringing a warm Ruach of Torah into the school, and infusing our children and families with a strong connection to Yiddishkeit.

Our teachers are responsible for creating and executing lesson plans in the classroom, enforcing classroom and school rules, observe and evaluate student performance, and grade homework and tests. They also have to keep parents updated on their children.

Year K to 6

A Torah Stream educators role can include any of the following areas of instruction:

- Chumash
- Dinim
- Parsha
- Kriah
- Yehadus.

In addition, they will be responsible for leading a daily classroom Davening.

The educator is expected to do much more than teach. They will be responsible for curriculum development, teaching composite classes with students of varying levels of knowledge and ability, creation of a Torah atmosphere, finding creative ways to engage and inspire the students, and introducing school wide programs eg. Middos and Mitzvah projects. Furthermore, the Torah Stream is part of a much larger secular Jewish day school which is open and willing to embrace the initiatives of our Torah Stream staff.

Due to the complexities of the composite classrooms, as well as the need to be actively involved in curriculum development, we are ideally looking for competent educator with a teaching qualification and a number of years of teaching experience.

Masada College Torah Stream of St. Ives, Sydney, Australia, is an Orthodox Observant Torah Stream which was launched in 2015. The stream is a part of an existing Jewish day school. The ideal candidate will demonstrate the ability to make a strong contribution to a blossoming Jewish day school.
