



UPDATED COVID GUIDELINES

What is new (6/10/2021):

- All unvaccinated individuals, including children, must continue wearing masks indoors. Children in groups (outside only) who maintain social distancing from others during the program can take their masks off.
- We are returning to pre-covid set up in the annex this week and will do the same in the main sanctuary next week. This is based on the very small number of masks we've seen the last 2 weeks and individual conversations with those individuals

What stays the same:

- All minyanim are mask optional
- We are now allowing for outdoor kiddushes to take place on the shul property with parameters installed to limit crowding. Parents are asked to get food for their children to avoid overcrowding by the food tables.
- We will no longer be requiring registration for minyanim.
- Please follow state guidelines regarding quarantine

We remind you that:

- Anyone who has tested positive for COVID must be cleared by a doctor for participation in a minyan.
- The minyanim are open to men, women, and children who are able to wear a mask properly and stay with a parent.
