UPDATED COVID GUIDELINES

What is new:

- In public spaces (including shul), all individuals are encouraged to continue social distancing and mask wearing. We will continue to offer indoor and outdoor services (weather permitting).
- Anyone who is fully vaccinated, or had COVID in the last 90 days, does not have a mandatory quarantine due to exposure. Those who are in quarantine due to direct exposure are asked to refrain from attending shul until after the required 10 day quarantine.

What stays the same:

- You must register for all Minyanim, even if you did so last week.

We remind you that:

- It is prohibited to attend a minyan if one is sick with any condition.. You will not be able to resume attending a minyan until cleared by a doctor. Anyone who has tested positive for COVID must be cleared by a doctor for participation in a minyan.
- The minyanim, are open to men, women, and children who are able to wear a mask properly and stay with a parent.
- Participants at minyanim, shiurim and shul events must follow social distancing and mask wearing guidelines, both at minyanim and wherever else is required to do so by the law.
- Please do not come to shul or any shul function while in quarantine.
