HOME DAVENING ONLY! Pesach schedule 5780

The First Bobover Rebbe (Rav Shlomo) once went to visit the famed Baron Meyer Anshel Rothschild. The Baron took the Rebbe on a tour of his palatial home, and his beautiful fountains and gardens. The Baron then took the Rebbe to the back of his property and showed the Rebbe a beautiful house which had a huge lock on the front door and said Rebbe this is my "pesach Shtub" my pesach home. This house is locked all year long and only used for pesach. The Baron thought the Rebbe would be impressed with his "Chumra" and was shocked when the Rebbe barely acknowledged what he had said.

The Baron inquired as to why the Rebbe was unimpressed? The Rebbe answered that his Zeideh was the famed Rav Chiam of TZANZ (Rav Chiam Halberstam). My grandfather was a man who was very scrupulous about his performance of each mitzvah and would spare no money to do them perfectly. If my grandfather did not have a "pesach shtub" for himself then obviously it's not needed!! The Rebbe explained the purpose of pesach and ridding ourselves of any chometz is not that we run away from it. The idea is not to escape from the battlefield of eradicating chometz which is a symbolism of the Yetzer Hora from within us. Rather the idea is to engage in battle and become warriors in searching and destroying the evil inclination from within us!

Having a "pesach shtub" a separate home only opened on pesach is running away from the battlefield in our quest for spiritual perfection. Living in our regular homes, preparing our homes erev pesach which is full of chometz and yes juggling all that we do on these few days preceding pesach when we must make sure that chometz does not touch our pesach utensils and food is all about bringing the battle to the Yetzer Hora and beating him!!

This year we are all making pesach and for many it's the very first time this is happening. Don't worry at all as it's actually the correct thing to be doing especially in these trying times. We are all on the frontlines of this battle to search and destroy the

Yetzer Hora. Every Jew is important in this battle, hopefully the final one as we hope for the revelation of the Moschiach and the return of the full splendor and glory of a rebuilt yerushalayim and Bais Ha'mikdash where we will all bring our Korbon Pesach together with all of Klal Yisroel.
